**EGYESULT IZZOLAMPA ES VILLAMOSSAGI
RESZVENYTARSASAG.**

"Circuit arrangement for the demodulation of electric oscillations modulated in frequency or modulated in phase."

Abstract.—This arrangement embodies the well known limiter and discriminator arrangement for the demodulation of frequency modulated or phase modulated signals.

In this the limiter anode circuit is damped by a circuit arrangement incorporating a diode in parallel with a choke and resistance in series. The cathode of the diode may be at earth potential. Across the resistor is connected a large value condenser acting as a reservoir. Further in the tuned transformer circuit of the limiter stage a tertiary winding is included one end of which is connected to the centre tap of the secondary and inductively coupled to the primary. The other end of this tertiary winding is connected between each of the two resistances and capacitors inserted into the cathode circuits of the discriminator diodes.
