NOTICE

THE following specification has been accepted:

No. 4,522 of 5th February, 1958. (*Convention application under Section 48, claiming priority date July 25, 1957, of German Patent Appln.*)

"Improvements in or relating to curved cylinder for relief printing machines having a removable stereotype plate carrying jacket"

Abstract.—This invention relates to a removable plate jacket super-imposed in a fork-like manner over the core of the curved cylinder of relief printing

machines. For this purpose the core of the curved cylinder is provided with corresponding guide surfaces, by means of which the exact position of the plate jacket in the peripheral direction is ensured.

The axial fixing is effected by means of an annular clamping device acting concentrically on the plate jacket and co-operating with a rotary ring oppositely disposed thereof, having a recess for engaging over the plate jackets. Thus the exact position of the plate secured on the outside of the machine on the jacket is accurately ensured.

It is claimed that in comparison with known removable stereotype plate jackets of curved cylinders for relief printing machines this invention reduces the duration of the stopping time for exchanges. Besides, this invention, it is claimed, overcomes the inherent fault of known constructions, viz.—the edges for applying the fixing and clamping cams having too small an area, whereby with the constant pressure stress the edges are subjected to wear and depending on increase in the period of operation the fixing means of the plate jackets are rendered doubtful.

The fork-like construction of the plate jacket enables the creation of sizes which extend beyond half of the cylinder, circumference by a considerable amount; but is also possible for plate jackets of half a cylinder circumference or less to be secured and retained in their position in this manner.

Thus it is possible to fit the curved cylinder with plate jackets of varying sizes depending upon what is required by the printing work. This facilitates manipulation.
