



Compositions based on 2, 4-Dichlorophenoxyethanol, for weed control in rice fields ".

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1, 2 and 3 which read as follows:-

1. A composition for the control of weeds in rice fields destined for sowing or transplantation, containing as active weedkiller substance, 2, 4-dichlorophenoxyethanol.

2. A composition according to Claim 1, including, as a diluent, a substance having fertilizing activity.

3. A method of controlling weeds in rice fields which comprises treating the rice fields with a composition according to Claim 1 or Claim 2.

"Improvements in structures".

Abstract.—This invention relates to structures.

According to the present invention, there is provided a structure comprising prefabricated panels, each provided with guiding or locating means and a keying element between the guiding or locating means of consecutive panels for securing the panels together, each keying element being of non-circular transverse cross section and each providing an axial triple container assembly incorporating a container for a column of a building material for rigidifying the joint between the panels, a container for a column of an insulating material, and a container for a column of air so as to provide an air space substantially along the length of the junction between two consecutive panels.



" 5-hydroxy-7-methyl-s-triazole (4,3-c)-pyrimidines and their preparation

Abstract.—The invention relates to 5-hydroxy-7methy-s-triazole-(4,3-c)-pyrimidines having the general formula



in which R is hydrogen or an alkyl, carboxyalkyl,

aryl, carboxyaryl or mercapto group.

A method of preparing a compound of the above type is described in which 2-hydroxy-4-methyl-6-hydrazino-pyrimidine is reacted with a carboxylic acid, acid chloride or acid anhydride at a temperature of from 20 to 120°C. and the 2-hydroxy-4-methyl-6-acyl-hydrazino-pyrimidine thereby formed is cyclized by heating to a temperature between 200° to 300°C. in the absence of solvents or the presence of boiling pyridine.
