### Trade Mark Notices

### Trade Marks Office

All communications relating to Trade Marks should be addressed to the Registrar of Trade Marks, Department of the Registrar of Companies, Block 5, Echelon Square, Colombo 1.

### Hours of Inspection

The office shall be open to the public every week day, except Saturday, between the hours of ten to four, and on Saturdays between the hours of ten to one, except on public holidays. Applications for inspections will, however, be accepted up to 3 p.m. on week days and 12 ncon on Saturdays.

### Trade Marks limited to colours

Where it is stated to the advertisement of an application that the mark upon its registration is to be limited to

certain colours, the colours are, as far as possible, indicated in the accompanying representation of the mark in the usual heraldic manner.

### Association

Where it is stated that an advertised mark is to be associated (under Section 22 of the Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap. 121)) with another mark, it is indicated by its official number.

### Applications in Part A or Part B

Applications for registration in Part A of the Register are shown with the official number unaccompanied by any letter. Applications for Part B of the Register are distinguished by the letter B prefixed to the official number.

### OPPOSITION

NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has grounds of objection to the registration of the following trade marks may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge notice of Opposition on form T. M. No. 7 bearing an uncancelled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration so as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the Notice of Opposition is incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an Opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

THE following specification has been accepted: -No. 4,538 of 26th March, 1958.

MAX HERMANN KNOCH.

"Hygenic device for cleansing the vagina."

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:-

1. A hygenic device for cleansing the vagina, comprising a flexible ball and a tube to be inserted into the vagina and communicating with said ball, said tube comprising a channel for drawing up cleansing liquid by suction with the ball and injecting it into the vagina. characterised in that the tube has a second channel, which does not communicate immediately with the interior of the ball and which, near the ball and near the outlet of the first channel, has one or more outwardly directed openings, said second channel having a volume at least equal to the volume of the ball and the first channel together, the first channel opening through the head of the tube into a countersunk part of the said head, which covers a much smaller projected area than said head and into which also one or more of the openings of the second channel discharge.

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1. Apparatus for treating tea leaf comprising two conveying surfaces between which tea leaf is fed, pressure-applying means adapted to subject the leaf to a plurality of pressure operations in the course of its travel between the conveying surfaces, and means for periodically relieving the pressure exerted on the leaf by said pressure-applying means.

Abstract.—According to the invention apparatus for the treatment of tea leaf comprises a rotatably mounted roller of large diameter, means arranged close to the surface of the roller to provide a nip for tea leaf carried between the roller and said means by rotation of the roller and means for vibrating said means and/or said roller in order to subject the leaf to a plurality of pressure operations in its passage through the nip between the roller and said means.
