"Method for treating bodies of water, such as canals, rivers, lakes, &c."

Abstract.—This invention relates to a method for treating bodies of water such as canals, rivers, lakes, &c., for the purpose of destroying submerged plant life. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1 and 2 which read as follows:—

1. Method for treating bodies of water such as canals, rivers, lakes, &c., for the purpose of destroying undesirable submerged plant life comprising the step of introducing into the water adjacent to said plants a phototoxic quantity of an olefinically unsaturated lower alkyl aldehyde.

2. Method according to claim 1, in which an aldehyde is employed having the following structural formula



wherein R stand for hydrogen or straight-chain alkyl radicals having not more than 5 carbon atoms.

There are 4 claims and 1 sheet of drawing.
