ORDER

- 1. The Orders under section 8 of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, published in *Gazette* No. 10,872 of December 23, 1955, and *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,504 of August 27, 1958, are hereby revoked.
- 2. The provisions of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, shall with effect from the date of publication of this Order, apply to the industrial products specified in column I of the Schedule hereto.
- 3. Every importer of an industrial product specified in column I of the Schedule hereto shall, in order to obtain a licence to import that industrial product, with effect from the date specified in para. 2 of this Order, purchase any one or more of the local products specified in the entry in column II of that Schedule.

NOTIFICATION

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section 1 of section 9 of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, I, Peduru Hewa William de Silva, Minister of Industries and Fisheries, in consultation with the Industrial Products Regulation Board, do by this Notification—

(1) revoke the Notifications under sub-section 1 of section 9 of the Industrial Products Act, No. 18 of 1949, published in *Gazette* No. 10,872 of December 23, 1955 and *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,504 of August 27, 1958, and

(2) prescribe—

(a) that, in order to obtain a licence to import the regulated products specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto, an importer shall purchase any one or more of the local products specified in Column II of that Schedule in the ratio specified in Column III thereof; and

(b) that the price at which any grade of local product specified in Column IV of the Schedule hereto will be sold to any applicant for a licence to import the regulated product shall be the price prescribed in the corresponding entry in Column V of that Schedule.
