HOSPITALS LOTTERIES ACT, No. 4 OF 1955

RULES made by the Hospitals Lotteries Board under section 10 of the Hospitals Lotteries Act, No. 4 of 1955, and approved by the Minister of Health under that section.

Rules

1. These rules may be cited as the Hospitals Lotteries Board (No. 1) Rules, 1955.

2. (1) Save as otherwise provided in paragraph (2) of this rule, meetings of the Board shall be held at such places and at such times as may be determined by the Chairman.

(2) Where a written requisition is made to the Chairman by not less than two members of the Board to summon a meeting for any purpose specified in such requisition, the Chairman shall, within seven days of the receipt of the requisition, summon a meeting of the Board.

3. The quorum for any meeting of the Board shall be four.

4. The Chairman shall preside at all meetings of the Board, and in his absence, the members present shall elect one of their number to preside at the meeting.

5. If at any meeting of the Board there is not a sufficient number of members present to form a quorum, the meeting shall stand adjourned to such date as the Chairman or other presiding member deems fit.

6. (1) All questions arising at any meeting of the Board shall be decided by a majority of the members present and voting at the meeting, the members present being not less in number than the quorum prescribed in rule 3.

(2) Where the votes of the members present at any meeting of the Board are equally divided in regard to any question, the Chairman or other member presiding at the meeting shall, in addition to his vote as a member, have a casting vote.

7. The Chairman shall, as soon as may be convenient after each meeting of the Board, transmit a copy of the proceedings of such meeting to the Minister.

8. The Secretary of the Board shall keep and maintain a record of the minutes of every meeting of the Board.

9. Any matter may, instead of being submitted to a meeting of the Board, be submitted for the decision of the Board by the circulation of the relevant papers to the members of the Board; and shall be so decided in accordance with the view of the majority of such members endorsed under their hand on such papers. Any decision made by the Board by the circulation of papers shall have the same force and effect as a decision made at a meeting of the Board, and shall be reported to the Board at its next meeting and thereafter entered by the Secretary in the minute book.

“ Chairman ” means the Chairman of the Board.
