- (i) revoke with effect from February 1, 1959, my Food Price Order No. KE 40 dated August 27, 1958, and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,511 dated September 2, 1958, in so far as it relates to the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price and retail dealer's maximum retail price mentioned in columns 2 and 3 respectively of the Schedule thereto of Maldive Fish mentioned in column 1 of that Schedule;
- (ii) fix with effect from February 1, 1959, the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be a wholesale dealers' maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett and a retail dealer's maximum retail price per lb. nett to a consumer respectively, above which Maldive Fish shall not be sold within the Administrative District of Kegalla;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for the purpose of resale, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (c) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of Maldive Fish which is less than or more than one cwt. nett and sold by wholesale should as usual be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett specified hereto.

- (iv) direct that within the Administrative District of Kegalla no person shall sell Maldive Fish which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v) direct that, within the Administrative District of Kegalla, every trader, who has any Maldive Fish in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for Maldive Fish specified in column 1 of the Schedule fixed by this Order;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (vii) direct that within the Administrative District of Kegalla every person who sells Maldive Fish by wholesale shall, and every person who sells Maldive Fish by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) the quantity of Maldive Fish sold (by weight);
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when Maldive Fish is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such Maldive Fish is sold.

- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (vii) direct that within the areas specified in column 1 of the two Schedules hereto every person who sells Maldive Fish by wholesale shall, and every person who sells Maldive Fish by retail shall on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;

  - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when Maldive Fish is sold the maximum prices referred to in column 2 of the two Schedules hereto shall include the price of the wrapper or the container if any in which such Maldive Fish is sold.

MUTTON

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Sylvester Justin Wijesekera, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Colombo District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Price Order No. FC/V-S.F. 3 (3) dated August 5, 1958 and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,469 dated August 5, 1958 ;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices per pound above which Mutton of the description and grade specified at the heads of those columns shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule ;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) " Mutton " shall mean the flesh of a sheep or goat, but shall exclude all forms of offal ;
  - (b) when the carcase of a goat or sheep as prepared for sale at the slaughter-house (i.e., excluding head, hide, entrails, hooves, all other forms of offal and such parts as are customarily excluded) is sold, the sale shall be deemed to be by " Dead Weight " ;

(iv) direct that when Mutton is sold with bones the weight of the bones sold therewith shall not exceed 25 per cent. of the total weight sold ;

(v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any Mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, or any vessel, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle or that vessel, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for Mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule fixed by this Order in that area ;

(vi) direct that when Mutton is sold together with offal in the course of one transaction the Mutton shall be weighed and sold separately from the offal ;

(vii) direct that every trader, when selling Mutton, shall so place his weighing scale or scales that the purchaser of the Mutton shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the Mutton he purchases ;

(viii) direct that every trader who sells Mutton of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the Mutton, on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale ;
- (b) the quantity of Mutton sold (by weight) ;

**THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950**

**Order**

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3(2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Sylvester Justin Wijesekera, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Colombo District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Price Order No. FC/V-S. F. 7 (2) dated August 20, 1958, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,478 dated August 20, 1958 ;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices per pound above which Country Beef of the description and grade specified at the heads of those columns shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule ;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) "Country Beef" shall mean the flesh of domesticated Indian or Sinhala cattle, or of a buffalo, but shall exclude all forms of offal ;

- (b) when the carcass of any animal as prepared for sale at the slaughter-house (i.e., excluding head, hide, entrails, offal, hooves and such other parts as are customarily excluded) is sold, the sale shall be deemed to be by "Dead Weight" ;
- (iv) direct that when Country Beef is sold with bones, bones sold therewith shall not exceed 25 per cent. of the total weight sold ;
- (v) direct that every trader who at any premises within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, has in his possession "Country Beef" of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of Country Beef of that description or grade ;
- (vi) direct that Country Beef shall be sold or exposed for the sale only in stalls set aside for this purpose and no meat of any other description and grade shall be sold or exposed for sale in those stalls ;
- (vii) direct that every trader who at any premises within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, has in his possession



- "Country Beef" of the description and grade specified in that Schedule, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at the stall where such beef is sold, a notice to the effect that only Country Beef of that description and grade is sold at the stall;
- (viii) direct that when Country Beef is sold together with offal in the course of one transaction the Country Beef shall be weighed and sold separately from the offal;
- (ix) direct that every trader, when selling Country Beef, shall so place his weighing scale or scales that the purchaser of the Country Beef shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the Country Beef he purchases;
- (x) direct that every trader who sells Country Beef of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the Country Beef, on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale;
- (b) the quantity of Country Beef sold (by weight);

- (c) the description of Country Beef sold; and
- (d) the price paid for the quantity of Country Beef sold;
- (xi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell the article specified in the Schedule which is adulterated with any other meat or flesh;
- (xii) direct that when the article specified in the Schedule is sold the maximum prices referred to in columns 2, 3 and 4 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (xiii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard avoirdupois weight.

**THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950  
 Order**

BY virtue of the powers vested in me, by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, read with section 3 (2) of that Act, I, Thambiah Sivagnanam, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Hambantota, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from February 1, 1959, Food Price Order No. 50 dated August 26, 1958,

and published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,511 dated September 2, 1958, in so far as it relates to the maximum wholesale and maximum retail prices mentioned in columns 2 to 7 of the schedule thereto of Maldive Fish mentioned in column 1 of that Schedule;

- (ii) fix with effect from February 1, 1959, the prices specified in columns 2 to 5 and 6 and 7 of the Schedule hereto to be the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett to a retail dealer, and a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett to a consumer,

respectively, above which Maldive Fish shall not be sold within the Administrative District of Hambantota;

- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for purpose of resale, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (c) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of Maldive Fish which is less than or more than one cwt. nett and sold by wholesale should as usual be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett specified hereto.

(iv) direct that within the Administrative District of Hambantota no person shall sell Maldive Fish which is adulterated with any other article;

(v) direct that, within the Administrative District of Hambantota, every trader, who has any Maldive Fish in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or in that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for Maldive Fish specified in column 1 of the Schedule fixed by this Order;

(vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order, "pound" or "lb.", shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;

(vii) direct that within the Administrative District of Hambantota, every person who sells Maldive Fish by wholesale shall, and every person who sells Maldive Fish by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of the sale;
- (b) the quantity of Maldive Fish sold (by weight);
- (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;

(viii) direct that when Maldive Fish, is sold, the the maximum price referred to in columns 2 to 5 and 6 and 7 of that Schedule shall include the price of the wrapper or the container, if any, in which such Maldive Fish is sold.
