THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Pararajasegarampillai Thambiah, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Vavuniya District, do by this Order:—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Price Order No. 50 of 25th August, 1958, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,508 of 29.8.58 in so

far as it relates to the maximum wholesale price and the retail dealer's maximum retail price mentioned in the First Schedule thereto of Maldive Fish mentioned in column 1 of that Schedule;

- (ii) fix with effect from this date the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett; and a retail dealer's maximum retail price per lb. nett to a consumer respectively above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto.

- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order:—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for purpose of resale, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (c) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of Maldive Fish which is less than or more than one cwt. nett and sold by wholesale should as usual be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per cwt. nett specified thereto.

- (iv) direct that, within the limits of Vavuniya District no person shall sell Maldive Fish which is adulterated with any other article;

- (v) direct that, within the limits of Vavuniya District, every trader, who has any Maldive Fish in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for Maldive Fish specified in column 1 of the First Schedule fixed by this Order in that area.

- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.

(vii) direct that in every area where maximum price is fixed by this Order every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule by wholesale shall and every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the same Schedule by retail shall on demand give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out :—

- (a) the date of the sale ;
- (b) the quantity of Maldive Fish sold by weight ;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity sold ; and

(d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

(viii) direct that the maximum wholesale and the maximum retail prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto shall include the price of wrapper if any in which such Maldive Fish is sold.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Allan Basil Samuel Nesarajah Pullenayagam, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Kandy District and Udahehahate D. R. O.'s Division of Nuwara Eliya District, do by this Order—

(i) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. KD-66 dated June 18, 1958, published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,367 of June 21, 1958 ;

(ii) fix with immediate effect the prices which for the time being have been fixed under the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, as the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett and the maximum retail price per pound nett of Dried Fish and Dried Prawns for the Colombo Municipality, increased by the amounts specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight nett and the

(iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell Dried Fish or Dried Prawns of the description specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto, which is adulterated with any other article ;

(v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any article specified in

the First Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for such articles fixed by this Order in that area;

- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in the First Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any article specified in the First Schedule by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the quantity of such article sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order, "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that when any article specified in the First Schedule hereto is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (ix) direct that in any sale of Dried Fish specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto, other than Kumbalawa, Bombili,

 - (c) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of rice which is less than or more than one hundredweight nett and sold by wholesale should, as usual, be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett ;
 - (d) "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight ;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article ;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any rice in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area ;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any rice by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale ;
 - (b) the quantity of the rice sold ;

- (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold ; and
- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail ;

(viii) direct that the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which the rice is sold.

(ii) fix with immediate effect the prices which for the time being have been fixed under the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, as the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundred weight nett and the maximum retail price per pound nett of potatoes for the Colombo Municipality, increased by the amounts specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto, to be respectively the maximum wholesale prices per hundred weight nett and the maximum retail prices per pound nett of potatoes above which potatoes shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto;

(iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

(a) any sale of any quantity of potatoes for the purpose of resale, or any sale of potatoes in a quantity of one hundred weight nett or more at a time, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;

(b) any sale of any quantity of potatoes in a quantity less than one hundred weight nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has potatoes in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for potatoes fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells potatoes by wholesale shall, and every person who sells potatoes by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale;
 - (b) the quantity of potatoes sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that when potatoes are sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper, or container, if any, in which potatoes are sold;
- (ix) direct that in any sale of potatoes in wooden crates imported from Holland the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less tare of ten pounds per crate;
- (x) direct that in any sale of potatoes in wooden crates imported from China the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a tare of 13 pounds per crate;
- (xi) direct that in any sale of potatoes in wooden crates imported from Japan the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a tare of 25 pounds per crate;
- (xii) direct that in any sale of any potatoes in any container other than wooden crates the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a tare of 3 pounds per container;
- (xiii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "nett" shall mean gross weight less tare, or naked weight of potatoes.
