FOOD SUPPLIES ORDINANCE, No. 30 OF 1947, AS AMENDED BY FOOD SUPPLIES (AMENDMENTS) ACTS, No. 7 OF 1955 AND No. 30 OF 1957

Order under Section 4 (2)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (2) of the Food Supplies Ordinance, No. 30 of 1947, I, Don Philip Rupasingha Gunawardena, Minister of Agriculture and Food, do by this Order amend the Schedule to the said Ordinance, revised by my notification dated October 21, 1958, in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 11,560 of October 21, 1958, by the addition of "Dates, Lentils, Masoor Whole and Split Lentils, Masoor Dhall" and the Schedule to now read as follows:—

Jaggery excluding Jaggery produced and shipped from the Republic of India and Pakistan

Lentils, Masoor Whole and Split Lentils, Masoor Dhall.

SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS (MALDIVE FISH)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4, read with 3(2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Anton Rothwell Mc Heyzer, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Trincomalee District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from February 1, 1959, my Food Price Order No. T/13/58 dated September 17, 1958, and published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 11,529 of September 22, 1958, in so far as it relates to the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price the retail dealer's maximum retail prices of Maldive Fish fixed by the order thereto;
- (ii) fix with effect from February 1, 1959, the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the First Schedule hereto to be a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett, a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett to a consumer and a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett respectively above which Maldive Fish shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned at the head of columns 2, 3 and 4;
- (iii) fix with effect from February 1, 1959, the prices for the time being fixed by me under column 3 of the First Schedule hereto as the maximum retail price per pound nett within the Trincomalee Urban Council area increased by the amounts specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per pound nett above which Maldive Fish shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule;
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for the purpose of re-sale, shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of Maldive Fish for the purpose of consump-

tion or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

- (c) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of Maldive Fish which is less than or more than one hundredweight nett and sold by wholesale should as usual be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett specified hereto;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader who has any Maldive Fish in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for Maldive Fish fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell Maldive Fish which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells Maldive Fish by wholesale shall, and every person who sells Maldive Fish by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of Maldive Fish sold (by weight);
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (ix) direct that when Maldive Fish is sold, the maximum prices referred to in this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or the container, if any, in which such Maldive Fish is sold.
