BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

A Proclamation

WHEREAS by Proclamation made under section 2 of the Public Security Ordinance, No. 25 of 1947, and published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,646 of January 26, 1959, the provisions of Part II of that Ordinance were brought into operation on the twenty-seventh day of January, One thousand Nine hundred and Fifty-nine, and those provisions will, by virtue of sub-section (2) of the said section 2, cease to be in operation on the expiration of the twenty-sixth day of February, One thousand Nine hundred and Fifty-nine:

AND WHEREAS I am of opinion that, by reason of the existence of a state of public emergency in Ceylon, it is expedient so to do in the interests of public security and the preservation of public order and for the maintenance of supplies and services essential to the life of the community:

KNOW YE that I, Oliver Ernest Goonetilleke, Governor-General, do, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the aforesaid Ordinance, by this Proclamation declare that the provisions of Part II of the aforesaid Ordinance shall come into operation on the twenty-seventh day of February, One thousand Nine hundred and Fiftynine.

Given at Colombo on the Twenty-sixth day of February in the year One thousand Nine hundred and Fifty-nine.
