THE EMERGENCY (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND POWERS) REGULATIONS

ORDER made by the Prime Minister under regulation 12 (1) of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations.

Order

1. This order may be cited as the Emergency (Public Processions and Meetings) Order No. 2.
2. Subject to the exemption contained in paragraph 3 of this order and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Emergency (Public Processions and Meetings) Order published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,679 of February 27, 1959, the holding of any public procession or meeting whatsoever in any part of Ceylon at any time during the period commencing at 8 p.m. on March 2, 1959, and ending at 6 a.m. on March 4, 1959, is hereby prohibited.
3. Any funeral procession to a place of burial or cremation the holding of which is authorised by a permit issued by the officer in charge of the police station in the area in which the funeral procession is to commence or by any police officer of a rank not below that of Assistant Superintendent is hereby exempted from the preceding provisions of this order.
