**THE DECISION**

This is a decision under section 34 of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950, as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts, No. 25 of 1956, and 14 and 62 of 1957. It relates to an industrial dispute between the Nidahas Karmika Saha Velanda Sevaka Vurthiya Samithiya (hereinafter referred to as "the Union") and the Lanka Power Lines Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Company").

2. The inquiry into this dispute was held by me and an award was made dated 3rd October, 1958. The award was published in terms of section 25 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950, in the *Ceylon Government Gazette*, No. 11,573 of 31st October, 1958. The third demand was with regard to award of a gratuity. My award was that a gratuity was payable at the rate of one half of a month's salary in respect of every 12 months of employment. The Company wanted clarification whether in the computation of the gratuity, the mid-day meal allowance should be excluded.

3. There are several Indian decisions with regard to the computation of the gratuity payable to employees. In the case of the Bombay Steam Navigation Company Limited, Bombay vs. Its Workmen, it was decided that the total wages exclusive of allowances should be the basis on which a gratuity should be paid (I, Labour Law Journal, 1953, page 357). There were similar decisions in *Caltex (India) Limited vs. Their Employees*, (II, Labour Law Journal, 1952) and in *Richardson & Craddas, Bombay vs. Their Workmen* (page 179 of Digest of Labour Law Cases by V. B. Kher.)

My award, therefore, is that the mid-day meal allowance should be excluded in the calculation of gratuities payable to the employees of the Company.

**ACCOUNTANCY BOARD, CEYLON**

Rules prescribed by the Accountancy Board pursuant to Regulations 6 and 6A of the Companies (Auditors) Regulations, 1941

THE rules published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 10,771 dated 4th March, 1955, are hereby amended as follows:—

1. Rule 3 (b) shall read—

“ possesses one of the following educational qualifications ”:

- (i) A Certificate of Selection by the University of Ceylon for admission into any Faculty of the University or passes at the Preliminary Examination of the University of Ceylon in four subjects on one and the same occasion.
- (ii) A Certificate issued by the University of London or by the Commissioner of Examinations, Ceylon, that the minimum entrance requirements for Registration and Matriculation in that University have been satisfied or a Certificate from the Commissioner of Examinations, Ceylon, of the possession of an equivalent qualification.
- (iii) The Matriculation Examination of the University of London, or a certificate of exemption from it through the Cambridge Senior Examination or through the Ceylon Senior School Certificate Examination.
- (iv) The Ceylon Senior School Certificate with Credit passes in—

- (i) English Language (English Language Syllabus A or English Language Syllabus B),
- (ii) Mathematics (Pure Mathematics or Elementary Mathematics (Special) or Elementary Mathematics (Ordinary).
- (iii) 3 other subjects from the following:—

Sinhalese Language, (Sinhalese Language Syllabus A or Sinhalese Language Syllabus B),	Tamil Language (Tamil Language Syllabus A or Tamil Language Syllabus B)

2. With effect from 1st December, 1959, the following paragraph in the syllabus for the Intermediate Examination, Paper No. 4: “ General Commercial Knowledge ” shall be deleted:

“ The objects and principles of costing. Questions will NOT be set involving the preparation of cost accounts ”.

The following paragraph shall be substituted in its place:

“ The objects and principles of costing including elementary problems in cost accounting. Questions will NOT be set involving double entry cost accounts ”.

3. With effect from 1st May, 1960—

- (a) the syllabus for the Intermediate Examination Paper No. 4 “ General Commercial Knowledge ” shall include the elementary principles and law of personal tax,
- (b) the syllabus for the Final Examination, Paper No. 4 “ Taxation ” shall include the principles and law of personal tax.

**RULES**

**APPLICATION FOR LICENCE**

1. In these rules, “Processed arrack” means arrack purchased from a Government warehouse or a licensed distillery and processed by the process of distillation, or by chemical or mechanical

processes, or by the addition of such ingredients as are approved by the Excise Commissioner or by a combination of two or more processes set out in this rule.

2. Every person desirous of obtaining a licence for processing of arrack shall make application in that behalf to the Government Agent of the Administrative District in which the premises to be used for such processing is situated. The applicant for such licence shall file with his application a description and plans of the building in which it is proposed to establish the manufactory, and of the still or stills, if any, and all the apparatus, which it is proposed to use for such processing of arrack.

#### REQUIREMENTS IN RESPECT OF PREMISES FOR PROCESSING OF ARRACK

3. (1) The licensed premises shall be set apart for exclusive use as a manufactory for the purpose of processing of arrack. There shall be no means of direct communication from the licensed premises to any adjoining premises. Sufficient accommodation shall be set apart in the licensed premises for such exclusive purposes as the Excise Commissioner may specify.

(2) The walls of the licensed premises shall be of cabook, brick or stone set in lime mortar, or of concrete. All windows, ventilators, drain outlets, and any openings other than doors in the walls shall be protected with expanded metal, having a mesh not exceeding one inch in width, permanently fixed to the walls. All doorways shall be fitted with doors of expanded metal to be used for closing the room during working hours in addition to other doors which may be used for the purposes of security at night. All openings on the ground floor shall be provided with inside wooden shutters.

(3) The floor of the licensed premises shall be of cement, and shall slope to a drain or drains along the walls, so designed as to carry away waste matter and water from the floor.

#### ARRACK TO BE PURCHASED FROM A GOVERNMENT WAREHOUSE; PURCHASE PRICE OF ARRACK

4. (1) All arrack for processing of arrack shall be arrack of ordinary quality, and shall be purchased in not less than 25 bulk gallons at a time, from a Government warehouse on payment in respect of every imperial gallon of the strength of London proof, of a sum equivalent to the current issue price payable by arrack renters under the Arrack Rent Sale Conditions in force at the time, and in respect of every imperial gallon of other strengths, a proportionate sum; Provided that in the case of a distiller, who in addition to holding a licence to process arrack holds a licence for the manufacture of arrack, the Excise Commissioner, may, in his discretion permit the arrack to be drawn from his distillery if he pays in respect of every imperial gallon of the strength of London proof, a sum equal to the current rate of gross profit recoverable by the Government on the sale to arrack renters of ordinary quality of bulk arrack, and in respect of every imperial gallon of other strengths, a proportionate sum.

#### TRANSPORT OF ARRACK

(2) No person shall transport from any Government warehouse or licensed distillery any arrack referred to in paragraph (1) except under the authority of a transport pass issued by an officer duly authorised by the Excise Commissioner.

#### EXCISE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF MANUFACTORIES

5. (1) The Excise Commissioner may appoint such officers of the Excise Department as he may deem fit for the supervision of any manufactory licensed for the manufacture of processed arrack, and it shall be the duty of the licensee to afford to such officers all facilities for the enforcement of the provisions of all excise rules applicable to such manufacture, and of the conditions of the licence.

#### LICENSEE TO PROVIDE ACCOMMODATION AND FURNITURE FOR OFFICE

(2) The licensee shall provide, within the licensed premises, accommodation for an office for the use of an officer appointed under paragraph (1) (hereinafter referred to as officer-in-charge) and the necessary furniture for such office to the satisfaction of the Excise Commissioner.

#### APPEAL TO EXCISE COMMISSIONER FROM ORDERS OF OFFICER-IN-CHARGE

6. Save as otherwise expressly provided, all orders made by any officer-in-charge shall be subject to appeal by the licensee to the Excise Commissioner. The appeal shall be made within fourteen days from the date on which the order is communicated to the licensee. The decision of the Excise Commissioner on any such appeal shall be final and conclusive.

#### ALL ARRACK TO BE KEPT IN CONTROLLED STORE

7. All arrack purchased for the purpose of processing of arrack shall be stored at the licensed premises in wooden vats or in such other receptacles as may be approved by the Excise Commissioner. Such storage shall be in a room exclusively set apart as a controlled store.

#### PROHIBITION AGAINST REMOVAL

8. No arrack which has been processed shall be removed from the licensed premises except under the authority of a permit for removal issued by the Excise Commissioner.

#### STORAGE OF ARRACK FOR PROCESSING DURING NON-WORKING HOURS

9. No arrack purchased for the purpose of processing shall be kept in the licensed premises during non-working hours, except under excise ticket-padlocks in storage vats, or under the seal of the office-in-charge in manufacturing vats, vessels, or receptacles, unless each room in which such arrack is kept is capable of being efficiently closed with excise ticket-padlocks, and is so closed.

#### SEPARATE STORAGE AND ACCOUNTING OF ALL ARRACK PROCESSED

10. All arrack which has been processed by the licensee under the licence shall be stored in the licensed premises separately from arrack purchased for the purpose of processing, and the licensee shall enter the particulars relating to such arrack in the proper books of account.

#### VATS AND OTHER RECEPTACLES TO BE LOCKED

11. All vats, vessels, and receptacles other than bottles, used in the licensed premises for the storage of arrack shall be so made as to be capable of being completely closed and kept locked under an Excise ticket-padlock, the key of which shall at all times be in the custody of the officer-in-charge, and under a separate padlock provided by the licensee, the key of which shall be retained by him, unless the room or rooms in which the arrack is stored is or are capable of being efficiently closed with Excise ticket-padlocks and are so closed when manufacturing operations are not being carried on.

#### STORAGE VATS AND OTHER RECEPTACLES TO BE LABELLED AS TO NATURE OF CONTENTS

12. All vats, vessels and receptacles used in the licensed premises for storage of arrack shall be correctly labelled to show the nature of the contents.

#### PRIOR APPROVAL OF INGREDIENTS TO BE USED

13. (1) The ingredients and agents to be used for the purpose of processing arrack shall be subject to the approval of the Excise Commissioner, and shall be of good quality, and no ingredient or agent disapproved by him or noxious to health shall be kept within the licensed premises, or be used in processing arrack, or be put into arrack which has been processed.

(2) The Excise Commissioner shall have the right to call for sufficient quantities of any ingredient or agent, which shall be supplied free of charge, for the purposes of analysis. The licensee shall not be called upon to pay the cost of any such analysis.

#### STORAGE OF APPROVED INGREDIENTS

14. The ingredients or agents to be used for the purpose of processing arrack shall be stored in vessels, receptacles or packages bearing labels with a correct description in English of the nature of the contents.

#### TRANSACTIONS PROHIBITED, EXCEPT IN THE PRESENCE OF THE OFFICER-IN-CHARGE

15. No arrack purchased for the purpose of processing, and no arrack which has been processed under the licence shall be received into or removed from the vats, vessels, or receptacles used for storage or manufacture in the licensed premises, except in the presence of the officer-in-charge, who shall gauge and prove all spirits so received or issued in the presence of the licensee or his agent. The licensee shall enter the particulars relating to such spirits in the proper books of accounts.

#### NOTICE OF MANUFACTURING OPERATIONS TO OFFICER-IN-CHARGE

16. When any manufacturing operations are to take place in the licensed premises, the licensee shall give to the officer-in-charge of the licensed premises at least forty-eight hours' notice of the days and hours during which such operations will take place. The licensee shall carry out such operations in accordance with the rules and conditions applicable thereto, and shall enter the particulars relating to the spirits manufactured by him in the proper books of accounts.

#### STANDARD OF PURITY OF PROCESSED ARRACK

17. (1) The standard of purity for each variety of processed arrack shall be prescribed by the Excise Commissioner by a notification published in the *Gazette*, and such variety shall conform to the standard laid down by the Excise Commissioner for it.

(2) The Excise Commissioner may empower the Government Analyst to add any substance, which is neither injurious nor deleterious to health, to any variety of processed arrack for the purpose of identification, if the Government Analyst deems it necessary. Such substance shall not be a substance which will affect the quality of the processed arrack.

(3) The Excise Commissioner may make such orders as he may deem fit as to the disposal of any manufactured spirits which do not conform to the standards laid down in the notification under paragraph (1) and such order shall be final and conclusive. The licensee shall be bound to comply with any orders so made.

#### MINIMUM AGE OF MATURITY OF PROCESSED ARRACK

18. No processed arrack shall be removed from the manufactory unless the processed arrack has been matured for not less than six months at the manufactory.

#### ANALYSIS AND RE-ANALYSIS OF ARRACK WHICH HAS BEEN PROCESSED

19. The Excise Commissioner may—

- (a) call upon the licensee to state the nature, composition, and proportion of all the ingredients and agents used, and the processes employed in the course of processing of arrack, if he deems it necessary;
- (b) call upon the licensee to pay a sum not exceeding seventy rupees to cover the cost of the first analysis of any new brand of processed arrack, and to submit, free of charge, a sufficient quantity of such arrack for analysis; and
- (c) call upon the licensee not more than once in four months, after the first analysis, to pay a sum not exceeding thirty rupees to cover the cost of re-analysis by the Government Analyst, and to submit, free of charge, a sufficient quantity of any manufactured spirits which the Excise Commissioner may desire in his discretion to have re-analysed.

#### REMOVAL OF PROCESSED ARRACK

20. No arrack which has been processed shall be removed from the controlled store, except to the room set apart for bottling, nor shall it be removed, after bottling except for sale in sealed bottles to renters of arrack taverns.

#### DUTY WHEN PAYABLE

21. A duty at the rate determined from time to time under section 21 of the Excise Ordinance (Chapter 42), and conveyed by the Excise Commissioner to the licensee in writing shall be payable by the licensee on every gallon of processed arrack before removal from the controlled store of the licensed manufactory.

#### REQUIREMENTS AS TO SANITATION AND PROTECTION AGAINST FIRE

22. The licensee shall take all such steps as may be necessary to ensure that—

- (a) the walls of the licensed premises are white-washed each year before the renewal of the licence, and the doors and windows and their frames are painted so as to keep them in a good and clean condition;
- (b) the floor of the licensed premises is properly washed and swept before the commencement of manufacturing operations, and the immediate surroundings of such licensed premises are swept daily;
- (c) all utensils and other articles used in the process of manufacture are at all times kept in a clean and sanitary condition, and in a good state of repair;
- (d) strict cleanliness is observed within the licensed premises and the grounds are kept bare and clear of grass, weeds, undergrowth, rubbish and stagnant water;
- (e) at least two fire extinguishers of a make approved by the Excise Commissioner, and suitable for dealing with ignition of spirits are installed within the licensed premises, and at least one fire extinguisher, suitable for dealing with ignition of dry material and approved by the Excise Commissioner, is installed outside such licensed premises; and
- (f) all such fire extinguishers are maintained in good condition and are in constant readiness for use, and all authorised employees are taught how to use them.

#### EMPLOYMENT OF WOMEN AND CHILDREN PROHIBITED

23. No male person under 21 years of age, and no female person of any age shall be employed in the manufactory.

#### DISEASED PERSONS NOT TO BE EMPLOYED

24. No person suffering from any infectious or contagious disease shall be employed in the manufactory.

Prohibition of admittance into manufactories of persons not having business therein.

25. (1) Except with the permission of the officer-in-charge, no person other than officers of the Excise Department, the licensee, his employees registered as hereinafter provided, and persons having legitimate business in the licensed premises shall be allowed to enter the licensed premises.

(2) (a) The licensee shall keep, in such form as the Excise Commissioner may direct, a register showing the names of all persons employed by him in the licensed premises.

(b) The licensee shall issue to each person employed by him in the licensed premises a pass signed by the officer-in-charge of such premises.

#### ACCOUNTS AND CUSTODY OF BOOKS OF ACCOUNTS

26. (1) The licensee shall provide and keep at the licensed premises such books of accounts and in such form as the Excise Commissioner may from time to time determine, and such books shall be in the custody of the officer-in-charge, and shall be kept under lock and key at all times, except when required for entering up, or for scrutiny by the licensee or his duly authorized agent. All entries shall be initialled and certified as correct by the licensee or his duly authorised agent.

(2) The licensee shall keep in ink true and correct accounts written in ink in English and these accounts shall always be entered up to date in the books referred to in paragraph (1).

(3) All spirits in the licensed premises shall at all times, be open to gauging and proving by any Excise Officer not below the rank of Inspector.

#### LICENSEE TO ACCOUNT FOR DEFICIENCY IN STOCKS

27. An account shall be taken of the licensee's stocks at least once in three months in such manner as the Excise Commissioner may direct. For wastage, a quantity not exceeding 1½ per centum shall be allowable, but on all spirits in excess of such allowance, which may not be forthcoming, and for which the licensee is unable to account to the satisfaction of the Excise Commissioner, the licensee shall pay to the Government a sum of fifty rupees for every proof gallon. Wastage for the purpose of recovery shall be calculated annually at the end of the year for which the licence is in force.

#### TRANSPORT WASTAGE

28. Allowance shall be made for wastage in the transport from a Government warehouse to the licensed premises at 1½ per centum.

#### GOVERNMENT NOT LIABLE FOR LOSS OF SPIRITS IN MANUFACTORIES

29. The Government shall not be held responsible for the destruction or loss of, or damage to, any spirits stored in any licensed premises.

#### REMOVAL OF SPIRITS AFTER EXPIRY OF LICENCE

30. On the expiry of his licence (unless a fresh licence has been granted to him), or on the cancellation or suspension of his licence, every licensee shall be bound forthwith to remove all spirits remaining within the premises for disposal in such manner as the Excise Commissioner may direct. If the licensee shall fail to remove such spirits within ten days of the receipt of a written notice from the Excise Commissioner, the cost of any staff employed thereafter in guarding or keeping watch over the premises may be recovered from the defaulter. In the event of continued neglect, the spirits shall be liable to be forfeited at the discretion of the Excise Commissioner.

#### LICENSEE BOUND TO OBEY ALL ADDITIONAL RULES

31. The licensee shall be bound by the provisions of the Excise Ordinance (Chapter 42), and by all such conditions and rules as may from time to time be made under that Ordinance in respect of premises licensed for the purpose of processing of arrack.

#### LICENSEE BOUND TO REPORT BREACHES OF LAW, COMMITTED BY HIS EMPLOYEES

32. If it comes to the knowledge of the licensee that any person employed by him has committed any breach of the provisions of the Excise Ordinance (Chapter 42) or of any rules thereunder, he shall immediately report the matter to the officer-in-charge, and shall comply with the directions of that officer respecting the continued employment of such person pending further orders from the Superintendent of Excise or a higher officer.

**Excise Notification No. 481**

**FORM OF LICENCE FOR PROCESSING OF ARRACK AND TO SELL PROCESSED ARRACK BY WHOLESALE**

THE Minister of Home Affairs has, under section 24 of the Excise Ordinance (Chapter 42), as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, directed that with effect from June 1, 1959, licences for processing of arrack and to sell processed arrack by wholesale shall be granted:—

- (a) on payment of a licence fee of five hundred rupees for the period of twelve months ending on September 30, or for any part of such period;
- (b) for a period of not more than one year;
- (c) in the form set out in schedule hereto; and
- (d) subject to the restrictions and the conditions contained in the said form.

7. The licensee shall not sell the processed arrack to any renter at less than the issue price payable to Government by arrack renters for double distilled quality of arrack.
8. No sale under this licence shall take place except between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

9. All notices shall be deemed to have been duly given to the licensee, if delivered at the manufactory or affixed to the door or gate thereof.
