Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration so as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the Notice of Opposition is incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an Opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

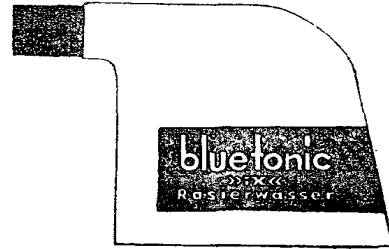

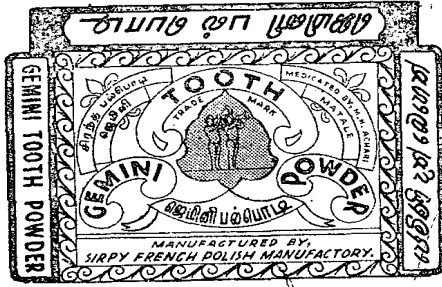

Notifications under the Patents Ordinance

THE following specification has been accepted:—

No. 4,565 of 28th July, 1958. (Convention application claiming priority date 8.8.57 of U. K. No. 25,064 of 1957).

TSOI NING.

"Improvements in or relating to electric dry batteries".

Abstract:—

The invention relates to an improved dry cell. The object of the invention is to secure battery elements from damp and the prevention of corrosive elements from escaping and damaging battery casings.

According to the invention, a dry battery is substantially enclosed in tight fitting jacket of flexible, waterproof insulating material. The enclosing jacket has apertures to expose a part of the electrodes of the battery. A metallic flange makes contact at the aperture to the consumable electrode and also bears on the part of the jacket making a further waterproof joint between the consumable electrode and jacket. This flange is rolled over at the edges of the jacket to securely fasten it to same. A second metallic flange contacts the carbonaceous electrode at the other aperture and bears on the portion of the jacket to make a water tight seal. This metallic flange is adequately insulated and secured by rolling together with a consumable electrode and a jacket.
