Trade Marks limited to colours

certain colours, the colours are, as far as possible, indicated in the accompanying representation of the mark in the usual heraldic manner.

Association

Where it is stated that an advertised mark is to be associated (under Section 22 of the Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap. 121)) with another mark, it is indicated by its official number.

Applications for registration in Part A of the Register are shown with the official number unaccompanied by any letter. Applications for Part B of the Register are distinguished by the letter B prefixed to the official number.

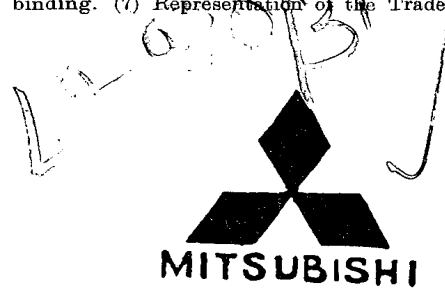
NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has grounds of objection to the registration of the following trade marks may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge notice of Opposition on form T. M. No. 7 bearing an uncanceled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration so as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the Notice of Opposition is incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an Opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

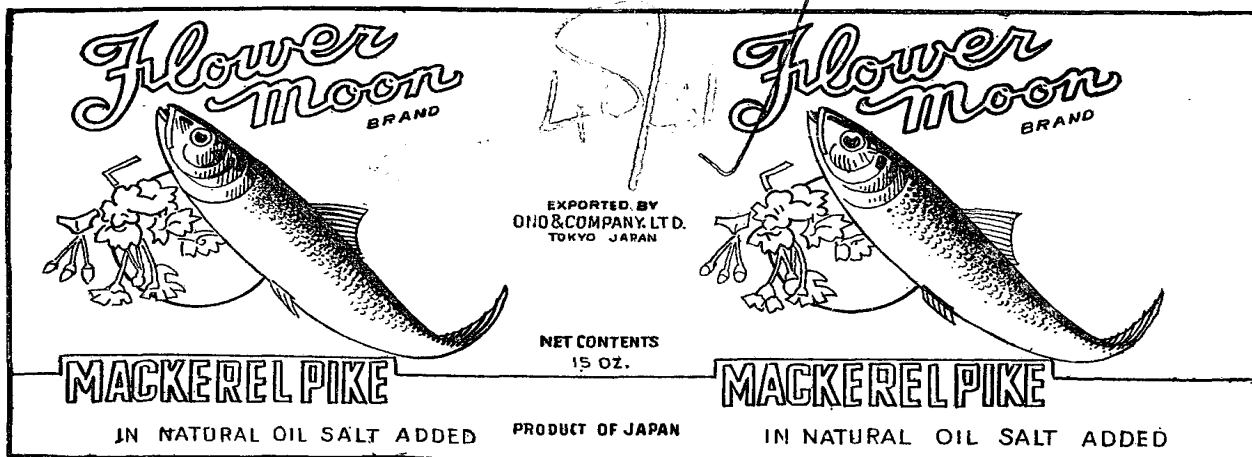

THE CEYLON INSTITUTE OF SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH.

"Improvements on Rainguards for Rubber and like trees".

Abstract.—This invention relates to rainguards for rubber and like trees.

The invention consists of a rainguard comprised of two components, or alternatively three components, made of rubber, plastic, resinous or other polymeric materials. Component one consists of a smooth continuously extended belt with a V, V-like or — like section. Component two consists of a continuously extended band of a width of up to 12 inches and up to about half inch thick.

Component three consists of a rolled or calendered sheet about 6 inches wide of a thickness about 1/4 inch. This should have a certain plasticity and thickness for sealing purposes.

A length of component two sufficient to wrap round the trunk after elongation is fitted to a tree by means of a suitable wire buckle so as to be stretched taut.

A sufficient length of component one is cut so as to permit encirclement of 4/5th or more of the girth of the trunk. The lower edge of component two is lifted sufficiently to permit of insertion of the full extent of the inner arm of component one behind or beneath the lifted area.

The third component is used in cases where the bark of the tree is too irregular to permit a good seal. It is introduced behind or beneath the upper edge of component two in a manner similar to the above.

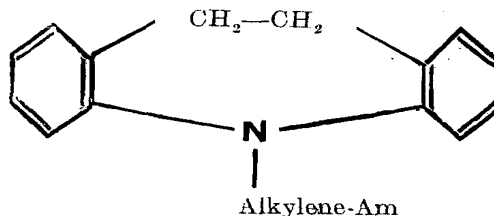

"Improvements in and relating to basic derivatives of imino dibenzyl compounds".

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1. A basic derivative of imino dibenzyl having the general formula:



where Alkylene represents an alkylene chain of 2-6 carbon atoms having attached thereto in β-, γ-, or δ- position the group Am which represents a low molecular dialkylamino radical (alkyl containing from 1-4 carbon atoms) or a N-piperidino-, N-morpholino, or N-pyrrolidino radical.

There are 2 examples and 7 claims.
