M. No. 7 bearing an uncancelled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration so as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the Notice of Opposition is incurred. Notifications under "The Patents Ordinance"

THE following specifications have been accepted:—

No 4,570 of 4th August, 1958. (Convention application claiming priority date 26.8.57 of Netherlands No. 220,225.)

N. V. DE BATAAFSCHE PETROLEUM MAATSCHAPPIJ.

"Process for the removal of carbon black from suspensions thereof in water".

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1. A process for the removal of carbon black from suspensions thereof in water by contacting these suspensions with water-immiscible auxiliary liquids, characterised in that the auxiliary liquid used is a hydrocarbon fraction having a boiling point or boiling range between 190 and 400°C, the aqueous carbon black suspensions are contacted with this hydrocarbon fraction at a temperature between 60 and 95°C, the aqueous phase being kept in a state of vigorous agitation, and the resulting carbon black-oil aggregates are separated from the aqueous phase.

ETABLISSEMENT PACOR.

"Polymerisation process".

Abstract.—This invention relates to new polymeric materials and methods of producing same. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1, 7, 14 and 15 which read as follows:—

1. A polyacrylic acid compound having a molecular weight exceeding 20,000, a crystalline x-ray diagram and a melting point above 120°C.

7. A method of preparing an isotactic polymer according to claim 1 by ion pair initiated low temperature polymerisation in solution of acrylic acid or a polymerisable derivative thereof.

14. A method according to claim 7 in which the catalyst is an alkyl or acyl derivative of a metal of the first, second or third column of the periodic system.

15. A method according to claim 7 in which the catalyst is selected from the group consisting of lithium, sodium and barium metal, triphenyl-methyl-lithium and -sodium, benzophenonyl-lithium and -sodium, fluorenyl-lithium, phenyl magnesium bromide etherates, tetra methyl ammonium-fluorenyl.

"Improvements in or relating to plant growth regulating composition".

Abstract.—According to the present invention, the plant growth modifying compositions comprise 3-Amino-1: 2: 4 triazole together with a chemically different substance capable of modifying plant growth.
