THE URBAN COUNCILS ORDINANCE, No. 61 OF 1939, AND THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTIONS ORDINANCE, No. 53 OF 1946

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 5, 6 and 80 of the Urban Councils Ordinance, No. 61 of 1939, and section 82 of the Local Authorities Elections Ordinance, No. 53 of 1946, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Mutu Banda Weerasekara Mediwake, Acting Minister of Local Government and Cultural Affairs, do hereby—

(1) amend the Order relating to the limits of the town of Wattagama and the number and limits of the wards of that town, published in *Gazette* No. 10,930 of May 18, 1956—

(a) in the First Schedule thereto, by the substitution, for all words and figures from "All that area of land situated" to "Elkaduwa Road over the said Polgahawagura Ela.", of the words and figures "All that area situated in the Village Headman's Divisions of Wattagama, Udurawana, Yatirawana and Yatawara in Pallegampaha Korale and Udagampaha Korale in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Pata Dumbara in Kandy District, Central Province, and bounded as follows:—

North: By a line drawn from the centre of the junction of the Village Committee road with Kudugala road north-eastwards along the northern edge of the Earth Drain until it meets the centre of the railway culvert; thence north-eastwards along the centre line of the Ela to the centre of its confluence with Delgahapeelle Ela; thence north-westwards along the centre line of Delgahapeelle Ela to the centre of its confluence with Dun Oya; thence north-westwards along the centre line of Dun Oya to a point in line with the western extremity of the northern limit of P. P. 7658; thence north-eastwards along the said northern limit of P. P. 7658 and along the extended line of the said limit in a straight line north-eastwards passing through lot K in P. P. 6174 and crossing the Ukuwela-Wattagama road to a point 2 chains east of the centre line of the said Ukuwela-Wattagama road; thence south-eastwards parallel to and at a distance of 2 chains from the centre line of Ukuwela-Wattagama road to the centre line of Dun Oya; thence northwards along the centre line of Dun Oya to the centre of its confluence with Polgahawagura Ela; thence south-eastwards, north-eastwards and again south-eastwards along the centre line of Pol-

gahawaguru Ela until it meets the centre of culvert No. 10/9 on Elkaduwa road over the said Polgahawagura Ela.; and

(b) in the Second Schedule hereto, by the substitution, for the description of the western boundary of Ward No. 1, of the following new description:—

West: By a line drawn from a point on the northern limit of the Urban Council area at the centre of the confluence of the Delgahapeelle Ela with the Ela; north-westwards, north-eastwards, northwards, north-westwards, north-eastwards, south-eastwards and northwards along the northern limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward; and

(2) declare that the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Order shall—

(a) in so far as they relate to any matter connected with the general election of members due to be held in the year 1959, come into effect on the date on which this Order is published in the *Gazette*; and

(b) in so far as they relate to any other matter, come into effect on the day immediately following the date of expiration of the term of office of the members of the Wattagama Urban Council who are in office at the date hereof.

LIMITS OF THE WARDS OF THE TOWN OF PUTTALAM

WARD No. 1

North: By a line drawn from the north-western corner of lot 2 in Preliminary Plan A 392—N. W. P. north-eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lot 2 to the centre of the bridge on Puttalam-Colombo road; thence south-eastwards along the centre line of the Puttalam-Colombo road to the centre of its junction with old Salt Store road; thence north-eastwards along the centre line of old Salt Store road to the centre of its junction with Puttalam-Kurunegala road; thence south-eastwards along the centre line of Puttalam-Kurunegala road to the centre of its junction with Puttalam-Anuradhapura road; thence north-eastwards along the centre line of Puttalam-Anuradhapura road to the centre of its junction with Koch's road.

East: From the last-mentioned point southwards along the centre lines of Koch's road and outer circular road to the centre of its junction with Paramadaluwa Waun.

South: From the last-mentioned point southwards and south-westwards along the centre line of outer circular road to the centre of its junction with Puttalam-Colombo road; thence by a line drawn due west through the centre of the said junction to the western limit of the Urban Council area.

West: From the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limits of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

WARD No. 2

North: By a line drawn from the centre of junction of Koch's road and Puttalam-Kurunegala road south-eastwards along the centre line of Puttalam-Kurunegala road to the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.

East: From the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area to its southern extremity.

South: From the last-mentioned point south-westwards, southwards and westwards along the southern limit of the Urban Council area to its western extremity.

West: From the last-mentioned point north-eastwards and north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 1; thence eastwards, north-eastwards and northwards along the southern limit of Ward No. 1 to the southern extremity of the eastern limit of Ward No. 1; thence northwards along the eastern limit of Ward No. 1 to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD No. 3

North: By a line drawn from the centre of junction of Manalkundu Waun and Nedunkulam Waun, north-eastwards along the centre line of Manalkundu Waun to the eastern limit of the Urban Council area.

East: From the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area to the eastern extremity of the northern limit of Ward No. 2.

South: From the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 2 to its western extremity.

West: From the last-mentioned point northwards along the eastern limit of Ward No. 1 to its northern extremity; thence by a straight line drawn north-westwards to the centre line of Sembukulam Waun adjacent to the south-western corner of lot 19 in Town Survey Sheet No. F 16/29 3 East; thence north-westwards along the centre line of Sembukulam Waun to the centre of its junction with Nedunkulam Waun; thence eastwards and north-eastwards along the centre line of Nedunkulam Waun to the starting point of the northern limit of the ward.

WARD No. 4

North: By a line drawn from the centre of junction of Nedunkulam (tank) bund and New Nedunkulam road eastwards along the centre line of Nedunkulam (tank) bund and Nedunkulam Waun to the western limit of Ward No. 3.

East: From the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the western limit of Ward No. 3 to the centre of junction of Koch's road and Puttalam-Anuradhapura road.

South: From the last-mentioned point south-westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 1 to the centre of junction of Puttalam-Anuradhapura road and Poles road.

West: From the last-mentioned point northwards along the centre line of Poles road to its northern extremity; thence westwards along the centre line of Marikar Street to the centre of its junction with New Nedunkulam road; thence northwards along the centre line of New Nedunkulam road to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD No. 5

North: By a line drawn from the western extremity of the northern limit of the Urban Council area to its eastern extremity.

East: From the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the eastern limit of the Urban Council area to the eastern extremity of the northern limit of Ward No. 3.

South: From the last-mentioned point south-westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 3 to its western extremity; thence south-westwards along the western limit of Ward No. 3 to the eastern extremity of the

northern limit of Ward No. 4; thence westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 4 to its western extremity; thence southwards along the western limit of Ward No. 4 to the centre line of Marikar street; thence westwards along the centre line of Marikar street to the centre of its junction with Chetty street.

West: From the last-mentioned point northwards and north-westwards along the centre line of Chetty Street to the centre line of Puttalam-Mannar road; thence northwards along the centre line of Puttalam-Mannar road and north-eastwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD No. 6

North: From the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 5 westwards along the centre line of Marikar street to the northern extremity of Poles road.

East: From the last-mentioned point southwards along the western limit of Ward No. 4 to its southern extremity.

South: From the last-mentioned point westwards and north-westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 1 and along the centre line of Puttalam-Kurunegala road to the centre of its junction with Chetty street.

West: From the last-mentioned point northwards and north-eastwards along the centre line of Chetty street to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD No. 7

North: By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area north-eastwards and south-eastwards across the Lake Shore street and along the centre line of 3rd Cross street to the western limit of Ward No. 6.

East: From the last-mentioned point south-westwards and southwards along the centre line of Chetty street to the centre of its junction with Puttalam-Kurunegala road; thence south-eastwards along the centre line of Puttalam-Kurunegala road to the northern limit of Ward No. 1.

South: From the last-mentioned point south-westwards, north-westwards and south-westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 1 to the western limit of the Urban Council area.

West: From the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD No. 8

North: By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Urban Council area and in line with the centre line of 5th lane, north-eastwards across the Lake Shore street and along the centre line of 5th Lane crossing Jausen Palli lane; thence eastwards along the said centre line till it meets the centre line of Puttalam-Mannar road; thence southwards along the centre line of Puttalam-Mannar road to the centre of its junction with Casim lane; thence eastwards along the centre line of Casim lane to the western limit of Ward No. 5.

East: From the last-mentioned point southwards along the western limit of Ward No. 5 to the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 5.

South: From the last-mentioned point north-westwards and south-westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 7 to the western limit of the Urban Council area.

West: From the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD No. 9

North: By a line drawn from the south-western corner of lot 16065 in Preliminary Plan 3637, North-Western Province; north-eastwards and south-eastwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the western limit of Ward No. 5.

East: From the last-mentioned point southwards and south-eastwards along the western limit of Ward No. 5 to the eastern extremity of the northern limit of Ward No. 8.

South: From the last-mentioned point westwards, northwards and south-westwards along the northern limit of Ward No. 8 to the western limit of the Urban Council area.

West: From the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Urban Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

Order under Sections 2, 5, 6 and 15

ORDER made by the Minister of Local Government and Cultural Affairs by virtue of the powers vested in him by sections 2, 5, 6 and 15 of the Town Councils Ordinance, No. 3 of 1946, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947.

ORDER

1. The area delimited in the First Schedule hereto shall be a town for the purposes of the Town Councils Ordinance, No. 3 of 1946 (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance"); and the administrative limits of that town shall be the limits set out in that Schedule.

2. The name and designation of the Town Council to be constituted under the Ordinance for the aforesaid town shall be the following:—

"Battaramulla-Talangama Town Council."

3. The number of members of whom the Battaramulla-Talangama Town Council shall consist shall be eight.

4. The town for which the Battaramulla-Talangama Town Council is to be constituted shall be divided into the eight wards defined in the Schedule hereto.

5. The date on which the term of office of the Battaramulla-Talangama Town Council shall commence shall be July 1, 1960.

FIRST SCHEDULE

All that area of land situated in the Villages of Madinnagoda, Kotuwegoda, Kalapaluwawa, Walpola, Battaramulla, Talangama North and Talangama South and part of the Village of Talawatugoda, in Palle Pattuwa of Hewagam Korale, Colombo District, Western Province, and bounded as follows:—

North: By a line drawn from a point on the centre line of Kolonnawa Ela where the northern limit of Madinnagoda Village meets the eastern limit of Kotte Urban Council area, eastwards along the northern limit of Madinnagoda Village until it meets the northern limit of Kalapaluwawa Village; thence north-eastwards, south-eastwards and eastwards along the northern limit of Kalapaluwawa Village, northern and eastern limits of Walpola Village and the northern limit of Talangama North Village to the northern extremity of the eastern limit of Talangama North Village.

East: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-westwards and south-eastwards along the eastern limit of Talangama North Village to the eastern extremity of the southern limit of Talangama North Village.

South: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-westwards and north-westwards along the southern limit of Talangama North Village until it meets the eastern limit of Talangama South Village; thence southwards and south-westwards along the eastern and southern limits of Talangama South Village until it meets a point on a line parallel to and 75 yards east of the centre line of the Public Works Department Road from Battaramulla to Pannipitiya; thence southwards and south-eastwards along a line parallel to and at a distance of 75 yards from the centre line of the said road until it meets a point due north-east of the centre of the culvert No. 3/6 on the said Public Works Department road; thence due south-westwards along a straight line and crossing the said Public Works Department road at the centre of the said culvert No. 3/6 to a point on a line parallel to and 75 yards south-west of the centre line of the said road at the centre of the said culvert.

West: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards and northwards along a line parallel to and at a distance of 75 yards from the centre line of the Public Works Department road from Battaramulla to Pannipitiya until it meets the western limit of Talangama South Village; thence north-westwards along the western limit of Talangama South Village until it meets the southern extremity of the western limit of Battaramulla Village on the centre line of Kolonnawa Ela; thence north-westwards and northwards along the western limits of Battaramulla-Kotuwegoda and Madinnagoda Villages which run along the centre line of Kolonnawa Ela to the starting point of the northern limit of the area.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Limits of the Wards of Battaramulla-Talangama Town Council

WARD NO. 1—MADINNAGODA-KOTUWEGODA

North: By a line drawn from a point on the western extremity of the northern limit of the Town Council area eastwards along the said northern limit until it meets the western limit of Kalapaluwawa Village.

East: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-westwards along the eastern limit of Madinnagoda Village until it meets the northern limit of Kotuwegoda Village; thence south-eastwards and southwards along the northern and eastern limits of Kotuwegoda Village until it meets the northern limit of Battaramulla Village.

South: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point westwards along the northern limit of Battaramulla Village until it meets the western limit of the Town Council area.

West: By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards and northwards along the western limit of the Town Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD NO. 2—KALAPALUWAWA-WALPOLA

North: By a line drawn from the northern extremity of the eastern limit of Ward No. 1 eastwards, north-eastwards and south-eastwards along the northern limit of the Town Council area to the landmark on the southern boundary of the Gansabhawa road leading to Mulleriyawa Udumulla at the north-western corner of lot 71 in P. P. 16,187, W. P.

East : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the northern limit of the Town Council area until it meets the northern limit of Talangama North Village; thence south-westwards along the northern and western limits of Talangama North Village to the eastern extremity of the northern limit of Battaramulla Village.

South : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point westwards along the northern limit of Battaramulla Village to the southern extremity of the eastern limit of Ward No. 1.

West : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards, north-westwards and north-eastwards along the eastern limit of Ward No. 1 to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD NO. 3—BATTARAMULLA " A "

North : By a line drawn from a point on the western limit of the Town Council area at the western extremity of the southern limit of Ward No. 1, eastwards along the southern limits of Wards Nos. 1 and 2 until it meets the western limit of Talangama North Village.

East : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards along the western limit of Talangama North Village and crossing the Public Works Department road from Kotte to Padukka to the northern limit of Talangama South Village; thence south-westwards along the northern limit of Talangama South Village until it meets the centre line of the Public Works Department road from Battaramulla to Pannipitiya.

South : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the centre line of the Public Works Department road from Battaramulla to Pannipitiya to the centre of its junction with the Public Works Department road from Kotte to Padukka; thence westwards along the centre line of the Public Works Department road from Kotte to Padukka to the western limit of the Town Council area.

West : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along the western limit of the Town Council area to the starting point of the northern limit of the Ward.

WARD NO. 4—BATTARAMULLA " B "

By-laws relating to Ferries

1. Where the Committee establishes a ferry within the village area, the Chairman shall cause notice of the establishment of the ferry to be given by beat of tom-tom.

2. The Committee may lease the right to collect tolls at any ferry established or maintained by the Committee to any person—

- (a) by private treaty,
- (b) by putting up the right to public auction, or
- (c) by tender.

3. All tolls levied at any ferry established or maintained by the Committee shall be collected by the ferryman appointed in writing by the Chairman or by the lessee or by the person appointed by the lessee with the written approval of the Chairman, as the case may be.

4. The Chairman shall cause to be exhibited in a conspicuous place at the ferry a notice setting out, in Sinhala, English and Tamil, the tolls payable for the use of the ferry, and no person shall demand or receive any sums higher than those set out in such notice.

5. The tolls imposed in respect of any ferry shall not be due and leviable when the ferry boat provided for carrying passengers or conveying goods or vehicles is not in use.

6. No person other than a duly appointed ferryman shall carry any goods, vehicle or animal which is not his property, or any passenger, who is not in his service, across any river or stream, by any boat or other means either at, or within, a distance of half a mile above or below, any ferry in respect of which tolls have been duly imposed by the Committee.

7. No private ferry shall be established in the village area without the prior permission of the Committee.

8. The Chairman shall cause to be maintained a register of all the ferries maintained by the Committee.

9. In these by-laws—

“ Chairman ” means the Chairman of the Committee, or where the affairs of the village area are administered by an officer appointed under section 61 of the Village Communities Ordinance (Chapter 198), such officers;

“ Committee ” means the Village Committee of the village area; and

“ Village area ” means the Uda Pattu village area in Kuruwita Korale in the Ratnapura District.
