PROCLAMATIONS BY THE GOVERNOR.

IN the Name of Her Majesty VICTORIA, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland Queen, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ARTHUR ELIBANK HAVELOCK, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by section 13 of "The Police Ordinance, 1865," it is enacted that the Proclamation establishing a Police Force in any town shall also specify and define the limits of such town, and that it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, from time to time as occasion may require by Proclamation to alter or vary such limits:

And whereas by a Proclamation bearing date the 14th day of November, 1878, a Police Force was, under the provisions of the said Ordinance, established in the town of Badulla, and the limits of the said town were, for the purposes of the said Ordinance, specified and defined in the schedule thereto:

And whereas it is expedient to alter such limits, and to redefine and specify the limits of the said town of Badulla for the purposes aforesaid:

Now therefore know Ye that We, the said Governor, with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, do hereby alter the limits of the said town of Badulla as defined in the schedule to the Proclamation of the 14th day of November, 1878, aforesaid, by substituting the limits set out in the schedule hereto for those set out in the Proclamation aforesaid as from and after the First day of January, 1893.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Fifteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-two.

SCHEDULE.

Limits of the Town of Badulla.

North.—Ridipána gap.

South.—Kudá-oya anicut to the bó-tree, from thence along the Hanwells, Kalugalpitiya, Etimola-éla to the Spring Valley cart road, thence along the same Etimola-éla to the tiled house occupied by Kiriwante, late Police Sergeant, and from that tiled house to the junction of the Mayilagastennakuda-oya with Badulu-oya, and thence in a straight line to the 82nd milepost on the Badulla-Nuwara Eliya road.

East.—From the Kuda-oya anicut along the Kuda or Rambukpota-oya to its junction with the Badulu-oya and thence along the Badulu-oya to the foot of the Ridipána hill and along the ridge to Ridipána gap.

West.—From the 82nd milepost along the ridge to Ridipána gap.

ABSTRACT OF SEASON REPORTS FOR SEPTEMBER, 1892.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy.—In Siyané Kóralé East and West a fairly good yala harvest is being gathered, but maha cultivation has suffered for want of rain. In Salpiti kóralé and Alutkúru Kóralé South the yala harvest has been exceptionally good. In Héwágam kóralé yala crops have not been so good as elsewhere, but maha cultivation is reported to be doing well.

The weather during the month has been perfect for harvesting. Maha crops early sown have not suffered under the fine weather; those sown late have in some places died out, and in other places been kept back.

NEGOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Yala crop being harvested; yield middling; most of the maha paddy withered away owing to recent drought.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Reaping of yala harvest completed; crop fair.

Dry Grain.—No cultivation.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Udunuwara, Yatinuwara, Tumpane, Harispattu, and Pata Dumbara: yala crop has been reaped, but is poor owing to damage by flies and want of rain early in month; maha now being sown. Udunuwara: yala crop fair but rain has interfered with harvesting. Pata Héwáheta: good yala crop. Uda Palata: maha crop sown; prospects good. Uda Bulatgama: fair yala crop. Maha has also been sown; prospects good.

Dry Grain.—The kurakkan crop in Udunuwara, Yatinuwara, Tumpane, Harispattu, and Pata Dumbara has been poor owing to want of rain early in month; reaping now delayed by rain. In Uda Dumbara rain has interfered with chena clearing for kurakkan. Pata Héwáheta: chenas being cleared. Uda Bulatgama: a good kurakkan crop has been reaped.

MÁTALÉ DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Yala crop secured, partly damaged by flies, especially in Mátalé South; maha sowing has begun.

Dry Grain.—Chena cultivation awaits the monsoon; rainfall fair in south, but very poor in north and east.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Young plants being weeded and transplanted in Kotmalé. In Uda Héwáheta and Walapané the young plants are doing well.

Dry Grain.—In Kotmalé a good crop of kurakkan, now in ear, is anticipated, while in Uda Héwáheta and Walapané chenas were cleared and burnt for kurakkan.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Sowing for the kalapokam of 1893 nearly completed; the plants of the earlier sowing are reported as being in very good condition.

Dry Grain.—Crops reported during the month generally fair.

Tobacco and Palmrah.—Good crop.

Weather.—There were some partial showers of rain on the 21st, 23rd, 24th, 26th, and 27th, and very heavy rain throughout the district on the 25th. Wind in general strong from about south-west during the month.

MANNÁR DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Sirupokam crops are still being threshed on the mainland; sowing going on for next kalapokam throughout the district.

Dry Grain.—Sowing going on in Mannár island alone.

Tobacco.—Lands being manured for cultivation.

MULLAITTÍVU DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Ploughing in progress on manawari lands. Preparations for kalapokam on tank lands have not yet commenced owing to tanks being all dry.

Dry Grain.—A limited extent being cleared for cultivation.

VAVUNIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Sirupokam crop reaped and stacked: average yield, but extent cultivated very small. No rain yet for kalapokam cultivation. Good crops under restored tanks.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Yala has been reaped throughout the district; harvest generally fair. Preparation for maha have commenced except in Bentota-Walallawiti kóralé.

MÁTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Four Gravets: good yala crop; maha cultivation commenced; recent rains have done great good, Kandaboda pattu: some parts, Hakmanawalakade and Kandapitawalakada, cultivated for maha, but greater part, including chenas, dependent on rain, and not cultivated yet. Gangaboda pattu: good yala crop; maha ma-wi crops suffered very much from drought. Weligam kóralé: good yala crop; maha cultivation commenced under favourable weather. Morowak kóralé: very poor yala crop, hardly four-fold; maha cultivation commenced. Wellaboda pattu: good yala crop; maha cultivation commenced.

Dry Grain.—Morowak kóralé: scanty crop of fine grain. Wellaboda pattu: very little fine grain.

HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—West Giruwa pattu : reaping of yala crops almost completed ; outturn middling ; maha cultivation commenced. East Giruwa pattu : yala crop in Modaragam palata reaped ; outturn good. Magam pattu : yala crops at Tissa and Western Walakada very good.

Dry Grain.—Extensive clearing going on of private chenas and Crown scrub jungle.

Weather.—Favourable, and food prospects generally fair.

EASTERN PROVINCE.

BATTICALOA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Late harvest of 1892 being reaped ; partly damaged by flood and blight ; sowing for 1893 commenced. Hoof disease still exists among cattle. Price of paddy Rs. 1.50 per bushel ; Indian corn and fine grain Re. 1.25

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Pinmari harvested throughout the district ; preparations for Munmari progressing. Health of cattle good. Rain has fallen favourably for sowing.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

KURUNĠGALA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Yala crops harvested throughout the district ; outturn bad, the crops having suffered much from long drought during the latter end of the month. Fields are being prepared ; sowing bala-wi for maha.

Fine Grain.—Clearing, sowing, &c., being done, but prospects are not good, want of rain being much felt.

PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Crop failed in Puttalam and Kalpitiya divisions for want of rain. In Demala hatpattu the crop, an average one, is ripening in some pattus, and has been already gathered in others.

Dry Grain.—Crops have failed in both Puttalam and Kalpitiya divisions for want of rain. In Demala hatpattu chenas have been cleared for next maha cultivation.

CHILAW DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Yala being reaped in all divisions ; crop small owing to want of rain ; sowing going on for maha.

Dry Grain.—Crops small in all divisions for want of rain ; chenas being sown for maha ; some have been cleared but not sown owing to want of rain.

Tobacco crops in southern division very good.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

ANURĀDHAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Yala crop is being reaped all over the Province, and is of exceptionally extensive area and of good quality except in some koralés where damage by insects is reported. The small tanks are exhausted, but the larger tanks and storage tanks still hold a good supply for next maha sowing owing to prohibition (*sic*).

Dry Grain.—Very little clearing for chena cultivation except on land sown last year.

Paddy Re. 1 a bushel. Murrain in three villages.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

BADULLA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Chenas being cleared for sowing ; the maha crop reaped is a good one.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Maha paddy sown in Kuruwiti and Nawadun koralés middling ; yala harvest gathered in other koralés, but in Kukuln koralé it is below the average.

Dry Grain.—Good chena crops expected in Nawadun, Kuruwiti, and Atakalan koralés. Prospects unfavourable in Kukuln koralé. Other koralés not yet sown.

KĠGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Hineti harvest nearly over : outturn in Three Koralés ; Lower Bulatgama and Paranakuru koralé, fair ; Beligal koralé and Galboda and Kinigoda koralés, poor, owing to flies and to the recent drought. Cultivation for maha not yet over, being retraded owing to the drought ; prospects good, provided the present rainy weather continues.

Dry Grain.—Kurakkan being reaped : outturn, Three Koralés and Lower Bulatgama and Galboda and Kinigoda koralés, middling ; Paranakuru koralé, fair ; Beligal koralé, poor. Weeding of hill paddy and iringu chenas over : prospects fair. Mun harvest over : outturn in Galboda and Kinigoda koralés, middling ; Paranakuru koralé, fair ; Beligal koralé, poor. Chenas are being prepared for amu sowing in Beligal koralé.

HONGKONG.—No. 386.

Beppu Light—Bungo Channel.

The following information has been received from the Japanese Government :—

This light, which is fixed white, is visible 2 miles all round, it is 33 ft. above the sea, in a white wooden square tower 18 ft. high.

Tokio Gulf—Yokosuka.

A sunken reef exists 1 cable N.E. by E. from Sakune reef, $1\frac{1}{2}$ fathoms least water, 52 ft. long, 32 ft. wide. Position, Yeboshijima Centre 36° Hohajima N.W. Point 71° Tadoga Saki.

Smith Island—Volcano Island.

Smith island is reported to lie 5 miles eastward of its charted position.

Volcano island seen from a distance of 10 miles in clear weather.

P. Takau—S. Formosa.

The following information has been received from H.M.S. Firebrand.

To cross bar, bring N.W. corner of Fort to bear E.N.E. Steer in on that course until north part of Saracen Head bears E. b N., when shape course through entrance. Flood and ebb tides set towards southern shore. Care must be taken on entering to starboard the helm as soon as possible to avoid grounding on spit inside entrance. This spit is gradually extending to the northward.

In mooring let go first anchor abreast Customs Flagstaff, the best holding ground in the harbour. Pilots uncertain. A good typhoon anchorage.

From a tracing of a plan made by a former Harbour Master at Takau in 1890 the following information is gathered :—

The one fathom spit to southward of the tower appears to have extended about 100 ft. to the north westward.

There is a slight decrease in the depths over the bar.

The leading mark given, viz., N.W. corner of Fort bearing E.N.E. appears to lead in deepest water over the bar, about $11\frac{1}{2}$ ft.

HONGKONG.—No. 373.

The following Notification received from the Consul for Russia is communicated for the information of all whom it may concern :—

"Beginning from the 6/18th July the light in Cape Povorotny, in latitude $42^{\circ} 40' 26''$ and longitude $133^{\circ} 02' 52''$, shows a fixed white light, and is visible all round from a distance of 24 miles. DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to exempt from Customs Duty official supplies consigned to certain Consular Officers of Foreign Countries.

- Preamble. **W**HEREAS Her Majesty's Consular Officers in the United States of America enjoy the privilege of exemption from customs duties in respect of official goods imported for the use of their Consulates, and it is expedient that a corresponding privilege should be granted to the United States consular officer in this Colony, and that provision should be made for extending a like exemption to the consular officers of any other foreign countries where now or at any future time a similar treatment may be accorded to British consular officers: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—
- Exemptions from customs duty. 1 From and after the coming into operation of this Ordinance, the following shall not be liable to payment of customs duty :—
- (a) All articles officially supplied to the United States consular officer in this Colony by his Government for the use of his consulate.
- (b) All articles supplied in the like manner and for the like use to the consular officer of such other foreign country as the Governor may from time to time name in a notification published in the *Government Gazette*.
- Exemptions how obtained. Certificate of consignees. 2 All articles consigned to any consular officer to whom this Ordinance applies shall be passed duty free on such officer delivering to the collector of customs a list of the articles, and certifying at the foot thereof that they are *bond fide* official supplies sent to him for the use of his consulate by his Government. Provided that all such articles shall, in case of the sale thereof after importation, be liable to and be charged with such and the same duties of customs as are ordinarily payable or charged on the like articles, and the officer in whose charge such articles may be shall furnish the collector of customs with the particulars of the sale thereof, and out of the proceeds of the same pay to the said collector the duties which may be due thereon.
- Governor may cancel exemptions. 3 It shall be lawful for the Governor, by notification published in the *Government Gazette*, to cancel any previous notification under section 1, in which case this Ordinance shall cease to apply to the consular officer of such foreign country as may have been named in such cancelled notification.

No. 9.—1892.

An Ordinance for imposing a Duty on Tavern Licenses within
Municipalities.

A. E. HAVELOCK.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinances Nos. 10 of 1844 and 13 of 1891, and to impose a duty on all licenses issued in respect of arrack taverns within Municipalities: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Stamp duty

tavern licenses
within
municipalities

1 (1) Whenever in pursuance of the provisions of section 26 of the said Ordinance No. 10 of 1844, as re-enacted by section 9 of the said Ordinance No. 13 of 1891, the government agent of a province issues a license to sell by retail arrack and rum at any tavern situated within the limits of a municipality, such license shall be subject to a stamp duty.

(2) The Governor in Executive Council shall from time to time, by notification in the *Government Gazette*, fix the amount of such duty, which may vary in different municipalities, but which shall in no case exceed five hundred rupees, and may, with the like advice, amend or alter any such notification.

No. 10.—1892.

An Ordinance relating to the registration of Marriages,
Births, and Deaths.

A. E. HAVELOCK.

Preamble.

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the legality of the registration of marriages, births, and deaths in this Colony, and it has become expedient to remove such doubts: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Irregular
registration
declared valid.

1 The solemnisation and registration of all marriages, and the registration of all births and deaths, which shall have occurred up to the date of the coming into operation of this Ordinance, shall be as valid and effectual for all purposes intended by, or relating to, or connected with the provisions

of the Ordinances No. 6 of 1847, No. 13 of 1863, No. 8 of 1865, No. 18 of 1867, No. 3 of 1870, and No. 9 of 1870, as if each and every of the registration districts had been duly established under the said Ordinances, and as if every person who had held, or who at the date of the coming into operation of this Ordinance is holding, the office of registrar of marriages, or the office of registrar of births and deaths, had been duly appointed registrar of marriages and registrar of births and deaths respectively.

Entries in registration books declared valid.

2 Every entry appearing in the books kept or purported to be kept in conformity with the provisions of the said Ordinances No. 6 of 1847, No. 13 of 1863, No. 8 of 1865, No. 18 of 1867, No. 3 of 1870, and No. 9 of 1870, shall be deemed to be valid and effectual for the purposes of the said Ordinances.

Saving clause.

3 Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall give any validity—

- (a) to the solemnisation or registration of any marriage, or the registration of births and deaths, except so far as relates to defects thereof caused by the non-establishment, imperfect establishment, or accidental abolition of any registration district, or by the irregular appointment or non-appointment of any person acting or purporting to act as registrar; or
- (b) to any marriage that may heretofore have been declared invalid by a competent court; or
- (c) to any marriage invalid by reason of the non-establishment, imperfect establishment, or accidental abolition of any registration district, or of the irregular appointment or non-appointment of any person acting or purporting to act as registrar, when the parties or either of them have or has subsequently contracted a valid marriage.

Short title.

4 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Marriages, Births, and Deaths Registration Amendment Ordinance, 1892," and it shall come into operation from and after such date as the Governor shall appoint by Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette*.

No. 11.—1892.

An Ordinance to authorise the appointment of Additional Provincial and District Registrars.

A. E. HAVELOCK.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make better provision for the registration of marriages, births, and deaths in the Colony: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Governor may appoint additional provincial registrars.

1 It shall be lawful for the Governor to appoint any person to be additional provincial registrar of marriages and additional provincial registrar of births and deaths for any Province, and such registrar so appointed at pleasure to remove. Every person so appointed shall, under the direc-

tion of the provincial registrar, exercise and perform all the powers, duties, and functions now vested in, and made exercisable by, the government agent as provincial registrar of marriages and provincial registrar of births and deaths for such Province under and by virtue of the provisions of Ordinances No. 6 of 1847, No. 13 of 1863, No. 8 of 1865, No. 18 of 1867, No. 3 of 1870, and No. 9 of 1870.

Governor may appoint additional district registrars.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor to appoint any person as additional registrar of marriages and additional registrar of births and deaths for any district of or in respect of which an assistant government agent shall be registrar, and such registrar so appointed at pleasure to remove. Every person so appointed shall, under the direction of the assistant government agent, exercise and perform all the powers, duties, and functions now vested in, and made exercisable by, the assistant government agent as registrar for such district under and by virtue of the provisions of the Ordinances specified in the last preceding section.

Passed in Council the Twelfth day of October, One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-two.

No. 12.—1892.

An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Savings Bank Ordinance, 1859."

A. E. HAVELOCK.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Ordinance No. 12 of 1859, intituled "An Ordinance for the better regulation of the Ceylon Savings Bank": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

To be read with Ordinance No. 12 of 1859.

1 This Ordinance and Ordinance No. 12 of 1859, hereinafter called the "principal Ordinance," shall be construed and read as one Ordinance.

Board of directors.

2 Wherever the words "the managing body" appear in the principal Ordinance there shall be substituted therefor the words "the board of directors."

Management.

3 For section 5 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—

"The bank shall be under the management of a board of three directors, who shall not directly or indirectly receive any salary, allowance, profit, or benefit whatsoever therefrom. Provided, however, that nothing in this section shall prevent any member of the board (or any officer of the bank) from becoming depositors therein on the same terms as others."

Board how constituted.

4 For section 6 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—

"The Colonial Secretary shall be *ex officio* the President of the board of directors. The other members of the board shall be nominated from time to time by the Governor."

Meetings. Quorum.

5 For section 8 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—

"The President shall appoint the times for the meetings of the board of directors for the transaction of business. At such meetings two directors shall be sufficient to form a quorum."

- Officers. 6 In section 10 of the principal Ordinance, for the word "actuary" shall be substituted the word "accountant," and for the words "of the said bank" shall be substituted the words "employed in the business of the bank."
- Directors. 7 In section 12 of the principal Ordinance for the words "five managers" shall be substituted the words "two directors."
- Depositors. 8 For section 18 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—
 "No depositor shall be allowed to deposit in the said bank any sum less than fifty cents at any one time or more than rupees one thousand in any one year, nor shall any depositor be allowed to have at any one time in the said bank a larger sum than rupees three thousand of principal."
- Extent to which charitable societies may deposit. 9 In section 19 of the principal Ordinance for the words "two hundred and fifty pounds" shall be substituted the words "rupees two thousand five hundred," and for the words "seven hundred and fifty pounds" shall be substituted the words "rupees seven thousand five hundred."
- Deposits by or on behalf of minors. 10 For section 21 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—
 "The said bank may receive deposits from or for the benefit of minors, subject to the same regulations as to deposits made by others, and it shall be lawful for the bank to pay to such minors the interest which may become due on such deposits. Any deposit made by or on behalf of any minor may be paid to him personally or to his guardian for his use if the deposit was made by any person other than the minor, together with the interest accrued thereon. The receipt of any minor or guardian for money paid to him under this section shall be a sufficient discharge therefor."
- Investment of deposits. 11 For section 23 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—
 "The several sums which shall from time to time be deposited in the bank shall be laid out at interest by the treasurer on the mortgage of immovable property in this Island, or in Government securities of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, or of India, or of this Island, or of any British Colony; and the treasurer is hereby empowered from time to time to sell or otherwise dispose of such securities. Provided, however, that any moneys remaining in the hands of the treasurer over and above the principal of the moneys deposited in the said bank may, until so invested as aforesaid, be deposited at interest by the treasurer in any bank approved by the Governor carrying on business in this Island."
- Treasurer 12 In section 24 of the principal Ordinance, for the word "trustees" shall be substituted the word "treasurer," and for the words "names of the trustees" shall be substituted the words "name of the treasurer."
- Actions by and against the bank. 13 For section 25 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—
 "All suits and actions to be instituted by or against the bank shall be instituted by or against the Attorney-General of the Island for the time being."
- Deposits and payments. 14 In section 26 of the principal Ordinance, for the word "actuary" shall be substituted the word "accountant," for the words "fifty pounds" shall be substituted the words "five hundred rupees," and for the words "secretary and one of the trustees" shall be substituted the words "secretary and one director."
- Bank officers to give security and to contribute to Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund. 15 For section 27 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—
 "The secretary, the accountant, and other officers of the bank receiving salaries from the funds of the bank are hereby declared to be public officers in the employment of the Government of Ceylon, and may be required to give security

for the due performance of the duties of their respective offices under the provisions of "The Public Officers' Security Ordinance, 1890." And all such officers in the receipt of salaries of not less than two hundred and fifty rupees per annum shall be liable to contribute to the Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund under the provisions of the Ordinance No. 20 of 1885 and the Ordinance No. 1 of 1890."

Letters of administration when to be dispensed with.

16 For section 28 of the principal Ordinance the following shall be substituted:—

"In case of the death of any depositor whose deposits, including interest thereon, shall not amount to rupees one thousand, and where the treasurer shall be satisfied by affidavit that the depositor died intestate, and that no letters of administration are required by law to be taken out, the treasurer shall be at liberty to pay the amount of such deposits to any person or persons appearing to him to be entitled thereto as heir or heirs at law of the deceased depositor; and such payment shall be a full discharge from all further liability in respect of the money so paid."

Effects of bank in whom vested.

17 In section 29 of the principal Ordinance for the words "trustees thereof" shall be substituted the words "the Government of this Colony," and for the words "the trustees of the Ceylon Savings Bank" shall be substituted the words "the Crown."

18 In section 30 of the principal Ordinance for the words "trustees of the said bank" shall be substituted the words "board of directors."

Repeal.

19 The definition of "Treasurer of Ceylon" in section 4 and the whole of sections 7 and 31 of the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Provided, however, that neither such repeal nor any of the provisions hereinbefore enacted shall affect—

- (a) anything duly done or suffered under any enactment hereby amended or repealed; or
- (b) any right, privilege, obligation, or liability acquired, accrued, or incurred under any enactment hereby amended or repealed; or
- (c) any investigation, legal proceeding, or remedy in respect of any such right, privilege, obligation, or liability, as aforesaid; and any such investigation, legal proceeding, and remedy may be carried on as if this Ordinance had not passed.

Commencement.

20 This Ordinance shall come into operation on such day as the Governor shall appoint by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*.
