Food Price Order No. KD—72.

RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, NO. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Allan Basil Samuel Nesarajah Pullenayagam, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Kandy District and Uda Hewahate Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Nuwara Eliya District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from June 15, 1959, my Food Price Order No. KD 170, dated February 10, 1959, published in Ceylon Government Gazette No. 11,665 of February 13, 1959;
- (ii) fix with effect from June 15, 1959, the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight nett above which rice issued in respect of the first half of the ration shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto;
- (iii) fix with effect from June 15, 1959, the prices specified in column 3 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per hundredweight nett above which rice issued in respect of the second half of the ration shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto;
- (iv) fix with effect from June 15, 1959, the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices of rice per pound nett above which rice issued in respect of the first half of the ration shall not be sold by retail in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (v) fix with effect from June 15, 1959, the prices specified in column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices of rice per pound nett above which rice issued in respect of the second half of the ration shall not be sold by retail in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) the maximum amount that is payable for any quantity of rice which is less than or more than one hundred-weight nett and sold by wholesale should, as usual, be calculated proportionately from the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett;
 - (d) no rice shall be deemed to have been issued in respect of the second half of the ration until all the rice issued in respect of the first half of the ration shall have been issued;
 - (e) "ration" shall be the quantity of rice issuable for the time being to the purchaser under the Food Control Act;
 - (f) "pound" or "lb" shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any rice in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area;
- (ix) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any rice by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of the rice sold;
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity of the rice sold; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (x) direct that maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price for the wrapper or container, if any, in which the rice is sold.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, NO. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I Chelliah Nitkunanathan, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Jaffna District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. J/7/1958, dated September 10, 1958, published in Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,525 of September 15, 1958, in so far as it relates to the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price mentioned in column 2, and 3 respectively of the First and Second Schedules thereto of Masoor Dhal and Maldivian Fish mentioned in columns 1 of these Schedules ;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett respectively, above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the same schedule shall not be sold within the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Jaffna (which includes the Municipal limits of Jaffna also) ;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the prices which are for the time being fixed by me as the maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett, for the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Jaffna (which includes the Municipal limits of Jaffna also), increased by the amounts specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett above which the articles specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto ;
- (iv) direct that paragraphs (iv) to (ix) of the Food Price Order No. J/7/1958 of September 10, 1958, relating to the Subsidiary Foodstuffs published in Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,525 of September 15, 1958, shall apply in the case of Masoor Dhal and Maldivian Fish mentioned in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto as those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.
