22ND ANIVERSARY OF THE NATIONAL LIBRARY AND DOCUMENTATION CENTRE

National Library and Documentation Centre conducted a number of programmes to commemorate the 22nd anniversary of the National Library and Documentation Centre. The inauguration ceremony was held on 26th April 2012 under the patronage of Hon. Bandula Minister Gunawardana, of Education. Under the programmes organised to mark the 22nd anniversary, a seminar on national library services was conducted for librarians and library science students. Mr. H.M. Gunaratna Banda, Mr. W. Sunil and Dr. Ruwan Gamage served as resource persons. In addition to the seminar, an exhibition of national library resources was conducted from 26th to 28th April 2012. A commemorative volume which includes articles on national library services was also published. A publicity programme was also carried out to make aware the Sri Lankan community about the national library services.

ANNUAL BOOK EXHIBITION

The annual book exhibition organised by the National Library and Documentation Services Board (NLDSB) was conducted from 25th to 27th May 2012 at the NLDSB premises. The objective of the exhibition was to provide the opportunity for readers to purchase books at concessionary prices. About 20 leading book publishers conducted stalls in the exhibition. Chief guest of the inauguration ceremony was His Excellency Hasani Pour, Ambassador of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Sri Lanka.

SURVEY ON LIBRARY CONSERVATION CENTRES

The Conservation Division of the National Libraray and Documentation Services Board (NLDSB) has conducted a follow up survey on the activities of the library conservation centres. 127 library conservation centres have been established in main public libraries throughout the country with the assistance of the NLDSB. National Library and Documentation Services Board hopes to improve the condition of these conservation centres on the findings of this survey.

WORKSHOP ON LIBRARY RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

National Library and Documentation Services Board conducted a workshop on library research methodology on 24.02.2012. The objective of the workshop was to make aware the library professionals about the

library research methodology. The workshop covered the areas such as introduction to library research, data collecting techniques and data analysis in library research. Mr. H.M. Gunaratna Banda, former Assistant Director General, National Institute of Education, Dr. Chaminda Jayasundara, Senior Assistant Librarian, University of Colombo and Mr. G.D. Amarasiri, Director, National Library and Documentation Services Board served as resource persons.

GRADING OF LIBRARIES

Grading of different types of libraries in Sri Lanka is a project carried out by the National Library and Documentation Services Board. During the period from January to June 2012, 57 public libraries, 2 school libraries and 2 department libraries have been graded.

AN IRAN CORNER WAS OPENED IN THE NATIONAL LIBRARY

An Iran Information Corner which includes books and other library material on Iran was opened in the National Library on 25th April 2012. The necessary equipments and library resources for the Iran corner were donated by the Embassy of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Sri Lanka. SCOPUS ABSTRACTING AND CITATION DATABASE

National Science Foundation (NSF) has made available facilities for local scientists to access to scopus (abstracting and citation data base) and TEE AL (full text journal database at the National Science Library and Resource Centre from Monday to Friday from 8.30.am to 4.00 p.m. Searching and downloading of information/ articles is free for research and educational purposes. Scopus is the largest abstract and citation database containing both peer-reviewed research literature and quality web resources. Scopus consists of over 18,000 journal titles from more than 5000 international publishers and offers researchers a quick, easy and comprehensive information to support their research needs in the scientific technical, medical, social science and humanities and arts fields. In addition to the journals, scopus also covers 425 trade publications, 325 book series and 250 conference proceedings. The total number of records in scopus as at present is over 46 (Essential million. TEEAL Electronic Agricultural Library) is a digital library in agricultural research and education. It is a full text and researchable database of articles from 200 high quality research journals in agriculture and related areas.
