A Proclamation



O. E. GOONETILLEKE

KNOW YE that, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section (1) of section 19 of the Army Act, No. 17 of 1949, I, Oliver Ernest Goonetilleke, Governor-General, do by this Proclamation call out on active service the Regular Reserve of the Ceylon Army and such parts of the Volunteer Force of the Ceylon Army as are specified in the Schedule hereto for the prevention or suppression of any civil disturbance in Ceylon.

Given at Colombo on the Twenty-fifth day of June, in the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-nine.
