THE CONTROL OF THE POSSESSION OF FOOD ACT, No. 14 OF 1956

REGULATIONS made by the Minister of Agriculture and Food under section 9 of the Control of the Possession of Food Act, No. 14 of 1956, and approved by the Senate and the House of Representatives.

D. P. R. GUNAWARDENA, Minister of Agriculture and Food. Colombo, 26th June, 1958.

Regulations

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Control of the Possession of Food Regulations, 1958, and shall come into operation on the 12th day of July, 1958.
- 2. Every person who is required so to do, by notice issued under the hand of the Food Controller, shall furnish to the Food Controller, on or before such date as may be specified in the notice, a return in such form as the Food Controller may direct, setting out such particulars as may be required by the Food Controller in respect of any scheduled article of food in the possession or under the control of such person or ordered, acquired or purchased by him or on his behalf during such period as may be specified in the notice.
- 3. (1) Where an Order under section 6 of the Act has been made determining the maximum quantity of any scheduled article of food, the Food Controller may, by notice issued under his hand, require every person to

whom such Order relates to furnish to the Food Controller or to such other officer as may be specified in the notice, before a date so specified, a return setting

- (a) the quantity of such scheduled article of food in his possession or under his control on the date on which the return is made, and
- (b) the premises where such quantity is kept.
- (2) Every person to whom any notice issued under paragraph (1) applies shall comply with the requirements of the notice.
- 4. (1) The Food Controller may at any time, by notice published in the Gazette and in at least one daily newspaper circulating in Ceylon, require every person who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of any scheduled article of food in excess of a quantity specified in the notice, to furnish to the Food Controller or to such other officer as may be specified in the notice, before a date so specified, a return setting out the quantity of such article in his possession or under his control and the premises at which such quantity is kept.
- (2) Every person to whom any notice under paragraph (1) applies shall comply with the requirements of the notice.
- 5. (1) Every person in charge of any institution or catering establishment shall, whenever required to do so by the Food Controller or any other officer authorised in writing by the Food Controller, furnish to the Food Controller or such other officer a return relating to the persons who are usually resident in such institution or establishment. Every such return shall be furnished in the form provided for the purpose by the Food Controller and shall contain all the particulars of the matters required to be stated in that form.
- 6. (1) For the purposes of determining whether an Order made under section 6 of the Act has been infringed, or of collecting information necessary for the purposes of the Act or of these regulations, or of testing the accuracy of any return made under these regulations, the Food Controller or any Food Control Inspector or Price Control (Food) Inspector may-
 - (a) question any person,
 - (b) examine any register or record maintained by any person, or
 - (c) by notice in writing, require any person to furnish within a period specified in the notice, a return specifying the stocks of that article of food in his possession or under his control or such information relating to the matters specified in the notice as may be necessary for the purposes of the Act or any regulation made thereunder.
- (2) Every person on whom a notice under sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (1) is served shall comply with the requirements of the notice.
- 7. Every Food Control Inspector and every Price Control (Food) Inspector is hereby authorised to inspect and search any place or premises used or reasonably suspected to be used for keeping any scheduled article
- 8. (1) Where any court under section 11 of the Act orders the forfeiture of any scheduled article of food, the court may make order that the forfeited article shall
 - (a) transmitted to the Government Storekeeper for the use of the Government; or
 - (b) transmitted to the Government Storekeeper or to any other specified officer for the purpose of being sold; or
 - (c) destroyed in such manner as the court may

- (2) The proceeds of the sale of any scheduled article of food forfeited by order of any court shall be credited to the Consolidated Fund of Ceylon.
- 9. Every importer of a scheduled article of food and every dealer in a scheduled article of food shall enter or cause to be entered in a register kept in such manner as the Food Controller may direct, every purchase and every sale made by him of that scheduled article of food and the stocks of that scheduled article of food held by him from time to time.
- 10. Every dealer in a scheduled article of food shall prepare a receipt in duplicate in respect of every sale of that article of food made by him. Every such receipt shall specify the date of the sale, the name and address of the person to whom the scheduled article of food was sold, the quantity sold, the price charged for such quantity and the name of the salesman who effected the sale. The original of the receipt shall be given to the person who made the purchase and the duplicate shall be retained by the dealer.
- 11. Every application under section 7 of the Act for a permit shall be in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.
 - 12. In these regulations—
 - "Act" means the Control of the Possession of
 - Food Act, No. 14 of 1956; Catering establishment "includes any boardinghouse, club, eating-house, hotel, lodging-
 - house, or restaurant; and "Institution" includes any hospital, charitable institution, religious institution or educational institution but does not include any hospital, charitable institution or educational institution to which the Act does not apply.

THE CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES ORDINANCE

RULE made by the Minister of Agriculture and Food by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 46 of the Co-operative Societies Ordinance (Chapter 107), as modified by the Proclamation published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, and approved by the Senate and the House of Representatives.

Rule

The Co-operative Societies Rules, 1950, published in *Gazette* No. 10,086 of March 24, 1950, are hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by the substitution, for rule 33 thereof, of the following new rule:—

'Co-operative Fund.

- 33 (1) A Fund hereinafter referred to as the "Co-operative Fund" is hereby established.
- (2) The Co-operative Fund shall be administered, subject to the direction of the Minister, by the Registrar who may utilise the money lying to the credit of that Fund for the purpose of—
 - (a) the audit and supervision of existing co-operative societies,
 - (b) rendering assistance to existing co-operative societies, and
 - (c) co-operative propaganda.
- (3) (a) Such balance out of the Contributions Fund established for the purposes of the audit and supervision of registered societies as is in the hands of the Registrar on the day immediately preceding the date of publication of this rule in the Gazette, shall be transferred to the Co-operative Fund.
- (b) Such amounts as are due to the Contributions Fund from registered co-operative societies on the day immediately preceding the date of publication of this rule in the Gazette, shall be deemed to be due to the Co-operative Fund."; and
- (2) by the insertion, immediately after rule 33, of the following new rule:—

"Annual contributions by registered societies to the Co-operative Fund.

33A. Every registered society shall, when called upon so to do by the Registrar, make annually a contribution to the Co-operative Fund of such amount, not exceeding five per centum of the net annual profits of the society and not less than five rupees, as the Registrar may determine."

IN accordance with the provisions of section 26A of the Wages Boards Ordinance, No. 27 of 1941, as amended by Ordinance No. 40 of 1943, and by Act No. 5 of 1953, the Wages Board for the Engineering Trade hereby notifies that the Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by section 28 of the Wages Boards Ordinance, No. 27 of 1941, proposes to vary, in the manner set out in the Schedule hereto, such decisions of the Board as are specified in that Schedule.

The decisions made by the Wages Board for the Engineering Trade and set out in the Schedule to the notification published in Gazette No. 9,447 of August 10, 1945, as varied in the manner set out in the notifications published in Gazette No. 9,523 of February 22, 1946, Gazette No. 9,837 of February 27, 1948, Gazette Extraordinary No. 10,229 of March 30, 1951, Gazette Extraordinary No. 10,542 of June 29, 1953, Gazette Extraordinary No. 10,811 of June 30, 1955, Gazette No. 11,224 of December 27, 1957, and Gazette No. 11,268 of February 28, 1958, shall be further varied in Part II of that Schedule, under the heading "Class of Workers", as follows:—

- (a) under the sub-heading "Semi-skilled workers, Grade I", by the omission of the item "crane drivers"; and
- (b) under the sub-heading "skilled workers", by the substitution, for the item "rivetters and caulkers", of the item "rivetters and caulkers; crane drivers".

THE INDUSTRIAL DISPUTES ACT, No. 43 OF 1950

Order under Section 4 (2)

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON THE VITAL STATISTICS OF CEYLON, 1957

THE main features of the Vital Statistics for 1957, are summarised below:—

Population

The estimated population of Ceylon at mid-year 1957 was 9,165,000 and at the end of the year 9,269,000. There has been an increase of 2.5 per cent. in the Islands' population during the year—the same as in previous year. The excess of births over deaths (natural increase) was 241,376 and of emigrants over immigrants was 12,343.

The population estimates given in this Report are corrected for under-enumeration of children under 5 years of age at the last census of 1953 and the rates herein are based on the corrected population.

Marriages

The total number of marriages registered in 1957 under the General and Kandyan Marriage Ordinance, was 49,795 (General 41,799 and Kandyan 7,996) as

against 50,852 in 1956. The marriage rate (per 1,000 of the Non-Muslim population) was 5.8 as against 6.1 in 1956, 5.8 in 1955 and 1954. Among the Muslims 5,164 marriages were registered in 1957 and the marriage rate was 8.4. The marriage rate in 1956 was 8.6.

Births

334,135 births (169,681 of males and 164,454 of females) were registered in 1957, an increase of 9,068 compared with the total registered in 1956. The sex ratio was 1,032 males to 1,000 females. The birth rate was 36.5 per 1,000 of the population as compared with 36.4 in 1956 and 37.3 in 1955. The total number of births registered in Colombo Town in 1957 was 31,092 as against 28,042 in 1956. The birth rate for the resident population of Colombo was 29.7 while the corresponding rate for 1956 was 29.3. The rates were 31.4 and 29.7 in 1955 and 1954. The number of births on estates registered in 1957 was 33,920 as against 33,263 in 1956.

Deaths

92,759 (47,796 of males and 44,963 of females) were registered in 1957 as against 87,561 in 1956. The death rate which was 9.8 in 1956 (lowest ever recorded) has gone up to 10.1. The rate was 9.8 in 1955 and 10.2 in 1954. In Colombo Town, a total of 8,845 deaths were registered in 1957 as compared with 7,976 in 1956. The death rate among the residents of that town was 9.4 per 1,000 of the population as against 9.0 in 1956. In 1955 and 1954, the rate was 9.8 and 9.9 respectively. The deaths on estates registered in 1957 amounted to 10,734 compared with 10,809 in 1956.

Infant Deaths

There were 22,551 deaths of infants in 1957 as against 21,617 in 1956. The infant death rate was 67.5 per 1,000 live births as against 66.5 in 1956. The 1956 rate was the lowest so far recorded for Ceylon. The infant death rate for the residents of Colombo Town was 76.7 as compared with 70 in 1956. The rate on estates was 102 as against 108 in 1956.

Maternal Deaths

The number of deaths from causes pertaining to pregnancy and child bearing in 1957 was 1,240 compared with 1,224 in 1956. The maternal death rate of 3.7 per 1,000 live births in mid 1957 is the lowest on record. The rate among residents of Colombo Town in 1957 was 3.2 while the rate on estates was 3.4.
