(2) in section 8—

(a) by the renumbering of that section as sub-section (1) of that section; and

(b) by the insertion, immediately after that sub-section, of the following sub-section:—

"(2) For the purposes of this section, a public servant who has served as a Commissioner of Assize shall be deemed to have held a permanent office during his tenure of office as a Commissioner of Assize.";

(3) in section 25, by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (iv) of that section, of the following paragraph:—

"(v) The pension of a public servant who has served as a Commissioner of Assize or as an acting Judge of the Supreme Court

shall for the period during which he has so served, be computed at the rate of 1/240ths of his salary for each month of his service as a Commissioner of Assize or as an acting Judge of the Supreme Court.”

2. The amendments made in the Minutes on Pensions by paragraph I of this notification shall be deemed to have come into effect on January 1, 1956.

2AD. For the purposes of sections 2, 2AB and 2AC of these Minutes, the expression “permanent office” includes a post held by an employee who is eligible for permanency and consequent pension rights after a fixed period of service in a temporary capacity, if such post has been declared pensionable by a notification published in the *Gazette*.”; and

(v) by the rescission of section 4A.

The decisions made by the Wages Board for the Printing Trade and set out in the Schedule to the notification published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,436 of July 21, 1945, as varied in the manner set out in the notifications published in *Gazette* No. 9,523 of February 22, 1946, *Gazette* No. 9,634 of November 22, 1946, *Gazette* No. 10,002 of July 29, 1949, *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,229 of March 30, 1951, *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,429 of July 30, 1952, *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,542 of June 29, 1953, *Gazette* No. 10,821 of July 29, 1955, *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,056 of January 30, 1957, *Gazette* No. 11,246 of January 24, 1958, and *Gazette* No. 11,291 of March 28, 1958, shall be further varied, by the substitution, for Part II of that Schedule, of the following new Part :—

“ PART II

(1) Wages for the printing trade shall be paid on a monthly basis.

(2) The minimum rate of wages for time work shall consist of a basic rate and a special allowance as set out below.

(3) (a) A worker of any class specified in this Part shall be paid as wages for any month mentioned in column I below an amount equal to the minimum monthly rate specified in respect of that class in this Part, if he has worked during the minimum number of working days specified in respect of that month in column II below : Provided, however, that the minimum number of working days specified in the aforesaid column II shall be reduced by one in respect of any month which has five Sundays.

For the purposes of this sub-paragraph, any day on which the employer fails to provide work to any worker who presents himself therefore shall be deemed to be a day on which such worker has worked.

(b) In respect of each such day of work in any month as is in excess of the minimum number of working days specified in respect of that month in sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph, the minimum rate of wages payable shall be an amount equal to twice the minimum daily rate ascertained by dividing the minimum monthly rate by 25.

(4) Where a worker has not been in employment for a full month he shall be paid as wages an amount which bears to the minimum monthly rate the proportion which the period of employment bears to the number of days in the month.

(5) Where by reason of any unauthorized absence a worker of any class specified in this Part has not worked in any month during the minimum number of working days specified in respect of that month in paragraph 3 (a), he shall be paid as wages for that month an amount which bears to the minimum monthly rate specified in respect of that class in this Part the proportion which the difference between such minimum number of working days and the number of days of unauthorized absence bears to such minimum number of working days.

(6) Absence from work on holidays or on days for which leave with full pay is allowed shall not be deemed to be unauthorized absence.

WHEREAS hoof-and-mouth disease has broken out among cattle in Divigandahe and Nikawagampaha Korales in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Hiriyala Hat Pattu in the Kurunegala District of the North-Western Province, I, Anthony Lloyd Perera, Government Agent, Administrative District of Kurunegala, in terms of section 4, sub-section (1) of the Contagious Disease (Animals) Ordinance (Chapter 327), do hereby declare an "Infected Area"—the area bounded on—

North: By Hatalispaha Korale East in Wannu Hat Pattu and Kalagam Palata in North-Central Province.

East: By Undurawa and Kiralawa Korales in North-Central Province and Ihala Otota Korale.

South: By Kimbulwana Oya.

West: By Wannu Hat Pattu and Hakwatuna Oya.

2. Under section 7 of the same Ordinance, I proclaim that no movement of cattle or cart traffic from and to these Korales shall be allowed, until this proclamation is revoked.

3. The attention of cattle owners and carters in the area, is drawn to the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Regulations, 1937, which lay down the actions which persons are by law required to take in an " Infected Area ". Details of these regulations can be obtained from the Government Veterinary Surgeon, Ibbagamuwa and the office of the Divisional Revenue Officer of Hiriya Hat Pattu at Ibbagamuwa.

4. This declaration shall take effect from the date hereof.

PROCLAMATION

FOOT and mouth disease having broken out among cattle in villages in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Kalagam Palata in the Anuradhapura District, I, Don Charles Lionel Amarasinghe, Government Agent, Anuradhapura District, in terms of Section 4 of the Contagious Diseases (Animals)

Ordinance (Cap. 327), hereby declare an ' Infected Area ' the whole of Kalagam Palata bounded as follows:—

North: Eppawela Korale in Nuwaragam Palata (West) and Ulagalla Korale in Hurulu Palata.

East: Matambuwa Korale in Hurulu Palata and the Northern boundary of Matale District.

South: Matale District.

West: Kurunegala District.

2. Under section 7 of the same Ordinance, I proclaim that no movement of cattle or cart traffic between one village and another shall be within the ' Infected Area ' for a period of two months from the date of this proclamation.

3. The attention of all cattle owners and carters in the area is drawn to Contagious Diseases (Animals) Regulations of 1937, which lay the action which persons are by law required to take in an ' Infected Area '. Details of these regulations can be obtained from the Divisional Revenue Officer, Kalagam Palata or from this Kachcheri.
