THE CEYLON (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1946

Order under section 61

ORDER made by the Public Service Commission under section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council 1946.

ORDER No. 111

1. The powers specified in column I of the Schedule hereto are hereby delegated to the officer or officers specified in the corresponding entry in column II of that Schedule, subject to the following conditions:—

- (a) Those powers shall be exercised according to such instructions as may be issued from time to time by the Public Service Commission.
- (b) Any person dissatisfied with the decision made by an officer under any power delegated to such officer under this Order may appeal therefrom to the Public Service Commission.
- (c) In any case where the Public Service Commission decides that any power of punishment delegated to an officer shall be exercised by the Public Service Commission, such officer shall not exercise that power in that case.

2. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed or construed to derogate from, or to affect in any other way, the right of appeal to the Public Service Commission conferred by section 61 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946.

3. The Order No. 68 dated June 30, 1953, and published in *Gazette* No. 10,551 of July 17, 1953, is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

I

- (1) The power to make appointments to any of the Civilian Posts in the Ceylon Air Force (other than posts in any of the Combined Services or of the Quasi Clerical Service), the initial salary of which is less than Rs. 4,080 per annum
- (2) The power to reprimand, reprimand severely, impose a fine not exceeding a week's pay, suspend, stop, reduce, or defer increment for a period not exceeding one year in respect of holders of Civilian Posts in the Ceylon Air Force, whose pensionable emoluments do not exceed Rs. 2,700 per annum or whose non-pensionable emoluments do not exceed Rs. 3,180 per annum
- (3) The power to dismiss or otherwise punish for misconduct on any ground other than on the ground of conviction, holders of Civilian Posts in the Ceylon Air Force (other than those posts specified in item 4 of this Schedule) whose pensionable emoluments do not exceed Rs. 2,700 per annum or whose non-pensionable emoluments do not exceed Rs. 3,180 per annum
- (4) The power to dismiss or otherwise punish for misconduct holders of Civilian Posts specified below whose pensionable emoluments do not exceed Rs. 2,700 per annum or whose non-pensionable emoluments do not exceed Rs. 3,180 per annum :—

Clerks (other than those in the General Clerical Service, Quasi-Clerical Service and Government District Clerical Service), Stenographers (other than those in the Stenographers' Transferable Service), Typists (other than those in the Typists' Service), Storekeepers, Librarian, Telephonists.

In this Schedule "Combined Services" means the Accountants' Service, the General Clerical Service, the Government District Clerical Service, the Typists' Service, the Stenographers' Transferable Service, the Translators' Service and the Service known as the Shroffs' Scheme.
