(b) Rent: Re. I per annum, subject to revision every 30 years provided the revised rent shall not exceed the rent recovered during the preceding period by more than

ov per cent.;

(c) The lessee shall, within 3 months of the commencement of the lease and to the satisfaction of the Government Agent, Kurunegala District, erect on the land a store a watch hut, office, lavatory and a well;

(d) The lessee shall use the land as a site for the purposes set out in (c) above, and for no other purpose.

3. The lease will be granted unless valid reasons to the contrary are adduced in writing to me within six weeks from the date hereof.
