Regulation

The Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,376 of June 27, 1958, are hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after regulation 43 of those Regulations, of the following new regulation:—

"Powers of arrest.

43A. Any Police Officer or any member of the Ceylon Army, Royal Ceylon Navy or Royal Ceylon Air Force may arrest without warrant any person who is committing or has committed or whom he has reasonable ground for suspecting to be committing or to have committed an offence under any emergency regulation."
