THE PUBLIC SECURITY ORDINANCE, No. 25 OF 1947

REGULATION made by the Governor-General under section 5 of the Public Security Ordinance, No. 25 of 1947, (as amended by Act No. 22 of 1949 and Act No. 34 of 1953), upon the recommendation of the Prime Minister.

Regulation

The Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,376 of June 27, 1958, are hereby amended, in regulation 29 of those Regulations, by the addition, at the end of that regulation, of the following new paragraph:—

“(19) Where a person detained in custody under an order made under this regulation is a person who prior to such detention was detained in custody under an order made under regulation 29 of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,321 of May 27, 1958, then, if he has duly made written objections against the earlier order of detention for the consideration of an Advisory Committee appointed for the purpose and such Committee has not made its report thereon, such objections shall be deemed to be objections duly made by such person against the order under which he is for the time being detained in custody.”
