BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Tuan Isakeen Cassim, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Badulla District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date Food Price Order No. BD/38 dated June 7, 1958, published in Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,352 of June 9, 1958, in so far as it relates to the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price and the retail dealer's maximum retail price mentioned in columns 3 and 4 respectively of the Schedule thereto of Masoor Dhal, Oorid (whole), Gram Dhal, and Potatoes mentioned in column 2 of that Schedule;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross, a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett to a consumer, respectively, above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule thereto;
- (iii) direct that paragraphs (iii) to (viii) of Food Price Order No. BD/38 of June 7, 1958, published in Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,352 of June 9, 1958, shall apply in the case of articles mentioned in column 2 of the Schedule hereto as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.

# PADDY (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Allan Basil Samuel Nesarajah Pullenayegum, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Kandy District and Udahewahate D. R. O.'s Division of Nuwara Eliya District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from July 10, 1958, Food Price Order No. KD. 41, dated May 4, 1956, published in Ceylon Government Gazette No. 10,928 of May 11, 1956, fixing maximum prices of paddy in the Kandy District and Udahewahate D. R. O.'s Division in the Nuwara Eliya District;
- (ii) fix with effect from July 10, 1958, the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per 80 measures nett above which paddy shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto;
- (iii) fix with effect from July 10, 1958, the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure above which paddy shall not be sold by retail in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto;
- (iv) direct for the purpose of this Order-
  - (a) that any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale:
  - (b) that any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (c) that "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any paddy which is adulterated with any other article;

- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any paddy in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area:
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any paddy by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any paddy by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) quantity of the paddy sold;
  - (c) the prices paid for the quantity of paddy sold; and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which the paddy is sold.
