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# German financial support for Wilpattu National Park Project

The German Government has extended financial assistance worth 8 million Euros for the implementation of a 7-year project titled "Supporting Wilpattu National Park and influencing Zone Management in Sri Lanka".

The Project commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) is being successfully implemented with the cooperation of the Wildlife Conservation

Ministry and the Wildlife Conservation Department.

The activities include enhancing the Park's infra-structure, supporting inter-agency coordination, better patrolling against poaching, securing and rehabilitating habitats and the control of invasive species.

The project consists of four fields of activity namely "improving the management capacity in technical and specialist terms", "improving conditions for the more resource-friendly use and conservation of marine resource in the

national park's influence zone", "better access to resource friendly income generation for the local population" and "raising environmental awareness and promoting peaceful coexistence".

The Wildlife Conservation Department staff in Kalpitiya and Wilpattu is to undergo training for the long term surveillance of marine resources. Under the project, tourism service providers will be trained on responsible dolphin and whale tourism.

Water purification systems have been set up in four selected villages to



address the growing issue of chronic Kidney disease affecting families around Wilpattu. Also the Park's management operational procedures were improved by providing patrol boats, motorcycles, GPS Tracking devices, cameras etc. Apart from this, the Park Bungalows and stations have been

equipped with solar PV systems.

The Wilpattu National Park located in the northwest of the country encompasses about 130,000 hectares. It is among the country's largest and oldest national Parks. This National Park is well known for its leopard population.

## Man arrested on money laundering charges

The Criminal Investigation Department (CID) on Tuesday arrested a 29-year old person for the offence of money laundering, Police Spokesman DIG Ajith Rohana said.

Investigations had revealed that Rs 17.2 million had been deposited to an account maintained in the name of this suspect in a private bank in Sri Lanka. The suspect, who is a resident of Veppankulam, Vavuniya, was arrested under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act.

"Initially, a complaint had been received to the CID in April 2020 on money laundering. According to that complaint Rs. 140 million had been deposited to accounts of various persons in Sri Lanka by accessing other persons' accounts illegally and those monies had come from various foreign destinations," the DIG said.

"The CID since April 2020 has arrested 36 persons in connection to this type of offences. The CID is conducting further investigations. The Financial Investigation Unit of the Central Bank is assisting the investigations," he added.

## Campaign against milk food industry, an eyewash - GMOF

The Government Medical Officers' Forum (GMOF) says the campaign against the milk food industry in Sri Lanka is nothing but absolute eyewash as there has never been a planned and sustained campaign against the trade if such efforts were to be considered genuine.

The milk powder industry has been targeted from time to time in an *ad hoc* manner and the lack of continuity on this score only points to the possibility of a 'conspiracy' against the milk food business in the country, the GMOF President, Dr. Rukshan Bellana said in a statement.

"There were two possible theories behind this campaign. The first was that some medical men who aspired to be politicians were merely orchestrating a spectacle to gain popularity in society. The other was that some players in the industry were behind the campaign to gain a competitive advantage", it asserted.

One may recall the vociferous campaign against the milk food industry at one time, where the 'target' was products imported especially from New Zealand. The question that begs an answer was why a particular imported segment was taken to task if milk powder, as a whole, was described as "harmful for consumption"? Therefore, it was obvious that a 'conspiracy' was in place with a certain medical trade union handling the anti-marketing campaign, the statement claimed.

"The anti-milk food campaign is bound to resurface in a few months' time. We, as a medical organisation, suspect that the local milk powder industry, in a bid to increase their market share, was probably behind the campaign against a milk powder brand imported from a particular country", Dr. Bellana claimed.

Was it a case of trying to edge out 'leaders' so that 'followers' could take their place through sustained campaigning with the support of a trade union? How was it claimed that imported milk powder was 'unsuitable' for consumption when there was neither scientific research nor laboratory evidence to prove that milk powder was unhealthy or harmful to the human body?, he asked.

There are, apart from food scientists, academics and research fellows, recognized research institutions in the country but none of them has produced any evidence on so-called 'harmful effects' of imported milk powder on the health of the people. In addition, there are also internationally recognized laboratories but there has been no evidence so far to substantiate such a hypothesis, the statement further said.

It is also of interest that not a single professional medical association has commented on the subject.

The Health Promotion Bureau of course promotes breast milk for children but that doesn't mean it has adopted an anti-milk powder stand. It is now clear that the campaign was launched to mislead the public and discourage them from consuming milk food especially products imported from New Zealand, it said.

"As a medical trade union, we believe that funding such misinformation campaigns and thereby misleading the public is against the law. However, there was no action forthcoming on this score," it outlined. The GMOF statement added: "We also see a move to popularize drinking so-called 'Kola Kenda' through a trade similar to the milk powder industry, where processed 'Kola Kenda' packets are being produced under diverse native names.

The move appears to be a bid to replace the milk-drinking habit of the population with 'Kola Kenda'.

"It was like in the early 1970's before the advent of the milk powder industry when there was a vibrant campaign to popularize drinking fresh milk. This later changed into packeted milk powder. 'Kola Kenda' has already come in packeted form. It is not the fresh, home-made healthy 'Kola Kenda' we have been used to for generations.

The most risky aspect of this proposition is giving schoolchildren packeted 'Kola Kenda' with preservatives and other chemicals added to the contents", the trade union warned.

In terms of international guidelines, we can be assured that the manufacturing process of milk food in New Zealand at least adhere to hygiene and highest quality standards, but the quality and safety of the locally manufactured packeted 'Kola Kenda' products are questionable, it said.

"At this rate, 'Kola Kenda' products in packeted form will soon be a multi-million rupee business," the statement added.



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# Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Zone to be established in Anuradhapura

The Cabinet of Ministers granted their consent to the proposal made by Health Minister Pavithra Wanniarachchi to establish the Anuradhapura Pharmaceutical Manufacturing Zone, Co-Cabinet Spokesman and Mass Media Minister Keheliya Rambukwella said.

Speaking at the weekly Cabinet media briefing held at the Government Information Department yesterday, Minister Rambukwella said that it has been planned to establish the Anuradhapura Pharmaceutical Manufacturing



Zone in Oyanamadu where the Deyata Kirula exhibition was held. It was decided to provide an opportunity for local investors to invest in this Zone for the production of high quality pharmaceutical products at a low price. All pharmaceutical

products will be manufactured according to the international standards.

An Experts Committee has already selected 24 investors. The investors are expected to invest approximately Rs.28,200 million for this purpose. Accordingly, the plots of land will be released through a lease agreement for a period of 35 years with a relief period of five years.

This project is scheduled to be conducted as a strategic project under the State Ministry of Pharmaceuticals Production and Manufacturing.

# Unlimited Internet facilities through ISPs from April this year

Prior to introducing unlimited Internet packages through the Internet Service Providers (ISPs), the Telecommunication Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka (TRCSL) should take steps to improve the telecommunication infrastructure in the country to maintain a stable internet speed, Information Technology Society Sri Lanka (ITSSL) emphasizes.

Issuing a media release, the ITSSL said the TRCSL has already informed the public that it would take steps to provide the customers with unlimited internet facility through the ISPs from April this year.

"But the problem is whether the existing internet backbone in Sri Lanka is strong enough to utilize unlimited services which need to maintain speed stability according to the international standards," it said.

"Such a move with no infrastructure capacity increased can cause a total collapse in the entire existing internet service system," it stressed.

The ITSSL also stressed that the internet cable landing stations owned by a few ISPs in Sri Lanka need to be evaluated properly to identify if they possess sufficient capacities to supply for the local internet users' demand.

The ISPs also should follow the international standards in maintaining stable internet speed limits, the society further said.

The TRCSL on March 19 had tweeted that it had issued a directive to all operators (ISPs) to respond with Unlimited Internet Packages by March 1 and it is currently assessing the packages submitted by complying operators.

Consumers could expect to have the first round of unlimited plans by April, the tweet further said.

# Country will never become a Western puppet - Prasanna

Tourism Minister Prasanna Rantunga said yesterday the passage of the UNHCR Resolution on Sri Lanka indicates that Sri Lanka is not a puppet of the Western countries.

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Abstention of 14 nations from voting on UNHRC Resolution

# 'More countries accepting Sri Lanka's position'

The abstention of 14 nations including India and Japan from voting on the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) Resolution on Sri Lanka is an indication that the incumbent Government's attempt to turn the tide in favour of this country on the international front was gaining results, Chief Government Whip Highways Minister Johnston Fernando said yesterday.

Commenting on the UNHRC Resolution during a meeting with journalists at his Ministry, Minister Fernando said the good work of the Government to win the international community's support was gaining solid results as proven by the majority out of 47 countries which either voted for or abstained from voting in support of Sri Lanka.

"Eleven nations including Pakistan, China and Russia voted for us while 14 others abstained in support of us. This shows that the majority of countries rejected the unwarranted and unjustified interference by a group of Western

nations in our internal affairs. All Asian nations stood in support of our country. This shows that we are on the right path to win the opinion of the international community," the Minister said. The Resolution was "unwarranted, unjustified and in violation of relevant articles of the United Nations' Charter," the Minister said.

"Our heroic Armed Forces militarily neutralized the LTTE in 2009 after three decades of conflict. The Government acted in self-defence to safeguard the unitary state, sovereignty and territorial integrity from the world's most ruthless separatist terrorist organization. It has all the rights to do so because the LTTE was the only terrorist organization in the world which has killed two world leaders: a serving President of Sri Lanka and a former Prime Minister of India extending its terror beyond the borders of Sri Lanka," he said.

The members of the international community should not forget the

fact that the end of terrorism guaranteed the most cherished of all human rights - the right to life of all Sri Lankans - Sinhalese, Tamils and Muslims.

"Several Western countries colluded against our Motherland in bringing an unsubstantiated Resolution against Sri Lanka. Those nations should keep in mind that they are acting not against a Government but against the aspirations of people in this country who have given us the mandate against UN resolutions. The Yahapalana Government, in a manner unprecedented in human rights fora, joined as co-sponsors of Resolution 30/1 which was against our own country. We pledged to withdraw from co-sponsorship of that Resolution when we campaigned for the last General Election and sought people's approval for that. They gave us a resounding victory. The rejection of this Resolution by the peoples of this country was clearly manifested in the mandate received by Presi-



dent Gotabaya Rajapaksa in November 2019. Based on this mandate, we withdrew from co-sponsorship of the Resolution," Minister Fernando said.

"Several countries working against Sri Lanka tabled another country-specific Resolution. Those are the very same nations that attempted but failed to save the LTTE during the last phase of war against terrorism. Their actions will result in a significant loss of morale among countries engaged in the struggle against terrorism," he said.

**Approval for suspended importation of ceramic products**

The Cabinet of Ministers granted approval to allow the suspended importation of ceramic products on a 180-day loan basis.

The Cabinet of Ministers on Tuesday approved a proposal made by Prime Minister Mahinda Rajapaksa in his capacity as the Minister of Finance to submit Gazette Notification No. 2214/56 issued on 11.02.2021 under the Import and Export Control Act No. 1 of 1969 for parliamentary approval.

The Gazette also permits the importation of sarees other than batik and handloom garments and textiles on a 90-day loan basis.

**UNHRC Vote: Chidambaram attacks Centre for abstaining**

Senior Congress leader P Chidambaram on Wednesday urged the people of Tamil Nadu to punish the AIADMK-BJP alliance in the upcoming state assembly elections for abstaining from the UNHRC vote on Sri Lanka.

He also termed the development as "gross betrayal of the Tamil people". India abstained from voting on the Resolution on Sri Lanka in the UN Human Rights Council. This is a gross betrayal of the Tamil people and their unanimous sentiment and desire, Chidambaram said on Twitter.

"The people of Tamil Nadu must and will punish the AIADMK-BJP alliance for this grievous blow to the interests of the Tamils," he said in another tweet.

India had abstained from voting, saying its approach to the question of human rights in Sri Lanka is guided by two fundamental considerations. One is support to Lankan Tamils for equality, justice, dignity and peace and the other is ensuring the unity, stability and territorial integrity of that nation.

**He had an unwavering will**

The 20th death anniversary of former Assistant Superintendent of Customs late Sujith Prasanna Perera, who paid the ultimate price for doing his job fearlessly, fell yesterday.

Sujith was shot on March 24, 2001, by two gunmen on a motorcycle when he was driving his car from his residence to work. At the time of his death, he was engaged in a series of investigations against unscrupulous importers and fellow officers who had worked hand-in-hand with such importers. This killing became a case of public interest and, after a speedy trial, the suspects were brought to book and sentenced to death.

Sujith left his wife Angela and his only daughter Ayesha, who was one-and-a-half years old at the time of his death. Sujith, having joined the Customs Department as a new recruit in 1989, was posted to its Intelligence and Investigation Unit. His investigating skills and ability to handle cases secured him a place at the Preventive Division, as a Preventive Officer, at a very young age.

Sujith became an intelligent and

an experienced investigating officer by handling many large fraudulent cases. His understanding of how to handle cases, untiring hard work, and in-depth knowledge of Customs Law made him an outstanding and memorable investigating officer of Sri Lanka Customs.

During his short career, he displayed dedication, courage, and the desire to fight against Customs Law offenders, and, in particular, the corruption within the Customs Department. He had a vision for a corruption-free Customs administration, and had no hesitation in leading from the front to expose those who were practising corruption.

Sujith set high ethical and performance standards to the Customs service and was an example to all officers, irrespective of seniority. He maintained high integrity and he had been commended by several heads of the Customs Department, as well as by several international investigating agencies he worked with closely to resolve customs frauds.

I had the privilege of working

with Sujith when I was posted as the Chief Preventive Officer in 1998. He was one of those rare officers who did not bow to internal, external, or political pressure. He focused and committed himself to his job, to the extent of disregarding even death threats against him. Irrespective of the parties involved, he carried out his investigations and never reserved himself from enforcing the law against those concerned.

As we pray for Sujith's soul to rest in peace, I feel there will be many of Sujith's calibre in the government service who could demonstrate and uphold a high level of integrity—who could fight and stand up against corruption. It is our duty, to encourage and pro-

text such officers who could make a difference in our motherland.

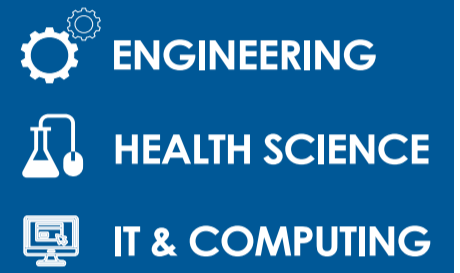

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# Equestrian obsession

## YOUNG ACHIEVERS

Nothing can compare to the adventure and beauty of riding a horse. Though riding looks so deceptively simple at first, it takes a lot of discipline and bonding to excel as a rider. Among the equestrian-dominant nations like the USA, France, Germany and the Netherlands emerges a skilled show jumper with a Sri Lankan lineage.

Adopted by a Swedish family when she was a three month old infant, Mathilda Karlsson has now gained global recognition for her equestrian talents. This gifted youth switched her nationality back to her motherland and vies to become the first Sri Lankan show jumper to compete at the Olympic Games.

A consistent rider on the Longines Global Champions Tour and current member of the Global Champions League (GCL) team, the Hamburg Giants, Mathilda dreams of making her home country proud.

"In Sweden, there weren't many dark-colored people 35 years ago. Though I was different from my classmates and friends, I always liked the attention I received. I never had any bad experiences so I didn't mind it at all. I still don't," she opened up the conversation.

Unlike many other countries which choose sports like soccer, basketball, surfing or cricket as a popular part-times for kids, horseback riding was the sport of choice for most Swedish children.

"It's like a social thing because all your friends attend these schools. So you go because you want to be with your friends. Once I got older, my friends dropped off. I stayed because I fell in love with the horses," Mathilda elaborated on how she started her equestrian career at the local club Kristianstads Rytarsällskap.

Her passion and dedication moulded her career path.

"I was never ever thinking of being an international show jumper. I never wanted to compete myself. I just loved grooming and hanging around.

Then, obviously, things changed and now I can't even imagine not showing," she revealed.

She says that her GCL teammates and former Swedish Chef d'Equipe, Sylve Söderstrand, have been part of her success.

"I was on the team with Rolf-Göran Bengtsson. He is someone I look up to. We would walk the course together, and he had so many good tips and advice that I would never have thought of. I learned a lot just by watching him and John Whitaker and being around them," Mathilda explained.

One of the pearls of wisdom she received from them that every week is a new week and even if you have a bad round, no one is going to think about it except for yourself.

"I was oftentimes worried about what other people would think, but they taught me how important it is to just let it go. Tomorrow is a new day, and a new class," she said.

She points out that equestrian sport is the only Olympic sport that men and women compete together. "It's a very time consuming sport and the most challenging part is probably interacting with your partner which in the case of an equestrian is their horse. I enjoy the excitement of show jumping. However, every good show jumper needs to have good dressage skills too," she said.

Her bonding with Sri Lanka came during her first visit here in 2017 which she described as a super experience. Stirred by the natural beauty of the isle and the hospitality of its people, Mathilda decided to switch to represent her birth country. She managed to achieve her wish supported by the Sri Lanka Equestrian Association.

"It was not an easy decision, as I was always very happy to be representing Sweden. I will always be Swedish, and a big part of my heart will always belong to Sweden. That is where I grew up, and where I have all my values from. However, I feel very proud and supported representing Sri Lanka. For me, it was the right thing to do," Mathilda explained.

One of her proudest moments in life was debuting under the Sri Lankan flag at the Longines Global Champions Tour of Monaco.

Her biggest challenge is ahead of her – qualifying for the Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan. Though the pandemic has postponed the event, Mathilda is keeping her fingers crossed and training to achieve her dream soon.

There are 200 slots allocated to equestrian between the three disciplines of show jumping, dressage, and eventing for the 2020 Olympic Games. Of those 200,

15 are reserved for individual show jumpers not qualified on a team. These individuals are chosen by FEI Olympic Ranking. From the South East Asia and Oceania region, which includes Sri Lanka, there are only two individual spots up for grabs.

Hard work and a positive environment are important when one is determined to achieve something. You must be surrounded by people who are positive and supportive. I am living in such a setting. Never underestimate a rider's dream," she noted adding that though it is a mammoth task, she will give it all that she has got. Her goal is to reach the top 100 in the world ranking.

Speaking about her Olympic mount, Holsteiner stallion Chopin VA (Casall x Coriano x Cantus), Mathilda notes that the horse was trained and taken to the highest level by her from his young days.

"Chopin and I have been inseparable since the day he was born. He and I have a very special connection. We are like best friends. At times, it feels like we can read each other's minds!" Mathilda adds.

Her advice for other young women is to become the queen of their own path.

"Every young woman should take the chance to become the best version of herself. Everything is possible, you just need to work a bit harder for it and never ever stop believing in yourself and your dreams," she concluded.

## 'Frozen's fifth spirit twist

'Frozen 2' has a major twist when the true nature of 'Frozen's fifth elemental spirit is revealed, but the ending should mean more for Anna in 'Frozen 3'. At the end of 'Frozen 2', the fifth spirit is shown to be Anna and Elsa, together, but the focus is much more on Elsa and her journey. The third 'Frozen' film is a good chance for Disney to explore the nature of the fifth spirit more deeply. The fifth spirit is said to be "a bridge between us and the magic and nature," according to Honeymaren, a member of the Northuldra. At the end of 'Frozen 2', Elsa seemingly discovers that she is the fifth spirit, gaining power over the four elements - water, fire, wind and earth. But as Elsa later reveals, the fifth spirit exists in the relationship between her and Anna. Their

sisterhood is what forges a bridge between magic, represented by Elsa, and the mundane, represented by Anna. As Elsa says, "a bridge has two sides, and mother had two daughters." Anna and Elsa freed the Enchanted Forest together. Anna's abilities aren't as visible as Elsa's, but her determination, resilience and love are critical to 'Frozen 2's happy ending. It's those traits that help Anna destroy the dam, revive Elsa and ultimately broker peace between the Northuldra and Arendelle. However, Anna does not get as much concrete recognition as Elsa. Although both end the movie by stepping into leadership roles - Elsa as the head of the Enchanted Forest and Anna as Queen of Arendelle - Elsa undergoes more visible changes, gaining new powers.

'Frozen 3' should take a closer look at how Anna grows into her role as one half of the fifth spirit. Anna's power is in her connection to people - her love for her sister, Sven, and the subjects of Arendelle. While Elsa jumps into the unknown, Anna is a grounding force, reining Elsa in whenever it looks like she might be going too far or risking too much. 'Frozen 3' might be able to highlight that trait by giving Anna the ability to neutralize magic or control volatile situations in some way. While 'Frozen 2' made it a point to avoid giving Anna magical abilities, perhaps she could act as an anti-magical force, bringing balance to power. Anna's love of the kingdom and its people was also explored in a song that was later cut from 'Frozen 2', "Home." 'Frozen 3' could show Anna's role as the fifth spirit by highlighting her love in a similar way, giving Anna a breakout song in the sequel.

## Will 'Godzilla Vs. Kong' get a sequel?

The greatest impediment to the future of the MonsterVerse is, obviously, the theatrical performance of director Michael Dougherty's *Godzilla: King of the Monsters*. That film didn't rack up the record breaking success that Gareth Edwards' *Godzilla* scored in 2014, on top of some questions and complaints pertaining to the more human angle to the story. As such, the entire universe seems to be at a moment of crisis. With plenty of monsters and sto-

ries in the Toho catalog yet to be touched, and a lot of different threads already presenting themselves at the end of *Godzilla: King of the Monsters*, that's an even more dangerous place to be.

Should 'Godzilla vs. Kong' be the final MonsterVerse film in the line, there's undoubtedly going to be a lot of potential left unexplored. As a shadowy corporation known as Apex is making the scene, and MechaGodzilla just might be in the mix, the story to Adam Wingard's next film doesn't feel like it's something that's ready to settle the books once and for all. Still the point stands: if the fans don't want more MonsterVerse stories, Warner Bros will certainly divert those resources keeping the franchise alive to other properties.

Maybe this is why long standing concerns like the darkness of *Godzilla's* picture are being corrected. Not only would this move for the 4K re-release of the first monstrous case file in this saga tweak the visuals to an even better level, but it might just help earn some goodwill at a time when 'Godzilla vs. Kong' could use as much as Titanly possible. March is the month that could determine the fate of the MonsterVerse, and 'Godzilla vs. Kong's March 31 release will be when the first signs will be spotted.
