## THE EMERGENCY (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS AND POWERS) REGULATIONS

RULES made by the Governor-General under regulation 25 (3) and regulation 29 (5) of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations.

Rules

1. Any person who is served with an order made in respect of him by the Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Difence and External Affairs under regulation 25 of the Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions and Powers) Regulations, or in respect of whom an order is made by such Permanent Secretary under regulation 29 of those Regulations and is carried into effect, may, within seven days after the date on which the order is so served or carried into effect, submit written objections against the order for the consideration of any Advisory Committee appointed for the purpose of the regulation under which the order is made.

2. The written objections referred to in rule 1 may be sent by registered post to, or be delivered at, the office of the Secretary to the Governor-General.

3. Every person who submits any objections for the consideration of an Advisory Committee shall be entitled to appear in person, or to be represented by counsel, proctor or other agent, before such Committee when his objections are taken up for consideration by such Committee.
