### PART I: SECTION (I)—GENERAL

#### DRIED FISH AND DRIED PRAWNS

#### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Arthur Cuthbert Bartholomeusz, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) for the Nuwara Eliya District, do by this Order—

- (1) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight gross above which the articles specified at the heads of columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" hereto shall not be sold within the corresponding areas specified in column 1 of Schedule "A" hereto;
- (2) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" hereto to be the maximum retail price per pound nett above which the articles specified at the heads of columns 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" hereto shall not be sold within the corresponding areas specified in column 1 of Schedule "B" hereto;
- (3) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" for the purpose of resale or any sale of an article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (4) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell any articles specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" which is adulterated with any other article;
- (5) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader who has any article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for such article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" fixed by this Order in that area;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight and "oz." shall be deemed to be the standard ounce avoirdupois weight;
- (7) Direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" by wholesale shall, and, every person who sells any article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" by retail, shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) the price paid for the quantity sold;
  - (c) the quantity of such article sold (by weight); and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (8) Direct that when any article specified in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" is sold the maximum wholesale and retail prices referred to in columns 2 to 21 of Schedule "A" and 2 to 13 of Schedule "B" shall include the price of wrapper, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (9) This Order shall not apply to the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Udahewaheta.

## Government Notifications

**FOOD SUPPLIES ORDINANCE, No. 30 OF 1947,  
AS AMENDED BY FOOD SUPPLIES (AMEND-  
MENT) ACTS, No. 7 OF 1955 AND No. 30 OF 1957**

### Order under Section 4 (2)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (2) of the Food Supplies Ordinance, No. 30 of 1947, I, Don Philip, Rupasingha Gunawardena, Minister of Agriculture and Food, do by this Order amend the Schedule to the said Ordinance, revised by my notification dated June 4, 1956, in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 10,937 of June 4, 1956, by the addition of "Garlic from People's Republic of China, Hongkong and Singapore" and the Schedule to now read as follows:—

### SCHEDULE

Paddy  
Rice

Any product of rice

Wheat

Wheat flour

Sugar

Sugar Candy excluding palmyra, sugar candy produced and shipped from the Republic of India.

Jaggery excluding jaggery produced and shipped from the Republic of India and Pakistan.

Red Onions

Garlic from People's Republic of China, Hongkong and Singapore.
