### SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS

#### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Hewa Dennie Weeraratne, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Administrative District of Galle, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date the Food Price Orders mentioned below-
  - (a) Food Price Order No. 5 of 1958 dated June 3, 1958, and published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,353 of June 10, 1958.
  - (b) Food Price Order No. 11 of 1958 dated July 10, 1958, and published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,425 of July 15, 1958.
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross to a retail dealer, a retail dealer's maximum retail price per lb. nett to a consumer, respectively, above which the articles specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the areas specified in column 1;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 2 of the Schedule for the purpose of resale or any sale of an article specified in column 2 of the Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 2 of the Schedule less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for such article specified in column 2 of the Schedule fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.

- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every person who sells any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out
  - (a) the date of the sale;

  - (b) the quantity of such article sold (by weight);
    (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
    (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 3 and 4 of that Schedule shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.

#### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Anton Rothwell McHeyzer, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Trincomalee District, do by this Order—

- (i) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices per pound above which Mutton of the description and grade specified at the heads of those columns shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule;
- (ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
  - (a) "Mutton" shall mean the flesh of a sheep or goat, but shall exclude all forms of offal;
  - (b) when the carcase of a goat or sheep as prepared for sale at the slaughter house (i.e., excluding head, hide, entrails, hooves, all other forms of offal and such parts as are customarily excluded) is sold, the sale shall be deemed to be by "Dead Weight";
- (iii) direct that when mutton is sold with bones the weight of the bones sold therewith shall not exceed 25 per cent. of the total weight sold;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, or any vessel, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle or that vessel, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule fixed by this Order in that area;
- (v) direct that when mutton is sold together with offal in the course of one transaction, the mutton shall be weighed and sold separately from the offal;
- (vi) direct that every trader, when selling mutton, shall so place his weighing scales that the purchaser of the mutton shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the mutton he purchases;
- (vii) direct that every trader who sells mutton of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto, shall give the purchaser of the mutton, on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of mutton sold (by weight);
  - (c) the description of mutton sold; and
  - (d) the price paid for the quantity of mutton sold;
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order no person shall sell the article specified in the Schedule which is adulterated with any other meat or flesh;

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order .

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Anton Rothwell McHeyzer, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Trincomalee District, do by this Order—

- (i) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices per pound above which Country beef of the description and grade specified at the heads of those columns shall not be sold within the areas specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule;
- (ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
  - (a) "Country Beef" shall mean the flesh of domesticated Indian or Sinhala Cattle, or of a Buffalo, but shall exclude all forms of offal;
- (iii) direct that when Country beef is sold with bones, the weight of the bones sold therewith shall not exceed 25 per cent. of the total weight sold;
- (iv) direct that every trader who at any premises within the areas specified in column 1 of the schedule hereto, has in his possession Country Beef of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of Country Beef of the description and grade specified in the Schedule fixed by this Order in that area;
- (v) direct that "Country Beef" shall be sold or exposed for sale only in stalls set aside for this purpose and no meat of any other description and grade shall be sold or exposed for sale in those stalls;
- (vi) direct that every trader who at any premises within the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto has in his possession "Country Beef" of the description and grade specified in that Schedule shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at the stall where such beef is sold a notice to the effect that only Country Beef of the description and grade is sold at the stall;
- (vii) direct that when Country Beef is sold together with offal in the course of one transaction, the Country Beef shall be weighed and sold separately from the offal;
- (viii) direct that every trader, when selling Country Beef, shall so place his weighing scale or scales that the purchaser of the Country Beef shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the Country Beef he purchases;
- (ix) direct that every trader who sells Country Beef of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the Country Beef on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the quantity of Country Beef sold (by weight);
  - (c) the description of Country Beef sold; and
  - (d) the price paid for the quantity of Country Beef sold;
- (x) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell the articles specified in the Schedule which is adulterated with other meat or flesh;
- (xi) direct that when the article specified in the Schedule is sold the maximum prices referred to in columns 2 and 3 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (xii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.

#### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, read with section 3 (2) of that Act, I, Malagodagamage Dayananda Amarasinghe, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Ratnapura District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date the Food Price Orders mentioned below-
  - (a) Food Price Order No. R/7/1958 dated June 4, 1958, published in Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,352 of June 9, 1958;
  - (b) Food Price Order No. R/9/1958 dated July 12, 1958, published in Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,425 of July 15, 1958;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross and the maximum retail price per pound nett respectively, above which the article specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto:
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of the article specified in column 2 of the Schedule for the purpose of resale or any sale of an article specified in column 2 of the Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight gross or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 2 of the Schedule less than one hundredweight gross for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail:
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for such article specified in column 2 of the Schedule fixed by this Order in that area;
- (vi) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight;
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) the quantity of such article sold (by weight);
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity sold; and
  - (d) the nature of transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (viii) direct that when any article specified in column 2 of the Schedule is sold, the maximum wholesale and retail prices referred to in columns 3 and 4 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold.
