REGULATION made by the Minister of Agriculture, Land, Irrigation and Power, under section 10 of the Tea Subsidy Act, No. 12 of 1958, as amended by the Tea and Rubber Subsidy (Amendment) Act, No. 66 of 1961.

The Tea Subsidy Regulations, 1958, published in *Gazette* No. 11,579 of November 7, 1958, as amended by regulation published in *Gazette* No. 11,836 of August 21, 1959, are hereby further amended as follows:—

(1) by the substitution, for regulation 2, of the following regulation:—

" 2. In accordance with the provisions of these regulations, the Tea Controller may, upon application made in that behalf in writing by the proprietor of a tea estate, tea small holding, rubber estate or rubber small holding, grant a subsidy to that proprietor from the Tea Subsidy Fund—

(a) for the purpose of replanting the whole or any specified part of such tea estate, tea small holding, rubber estate or rubber small holding; or

(b) for the purpose of rehabilitating the whole or any specified part of such tea estate or tea small holding;" ;
(2) by the substitution, for regulation 4, of the following regulation:—

" 4. (1) The amount of the subsidy payable for replanting the whole or any specified part of a tea estate or tea small holding shall be Rs. 2,500 in respect of each acre of the area to be replanted, and shall be paid in six instalments in the following manner:—

- (a) the first instalment of Rs. 500 for each acre shall be paid after the eradication of the existing tea plants or other vegetation;
- (b) the second instalment of Rs. 750 for each acre shall be paid after soil conservation measures have been adopted;
- (c) the third instalment of Rs. 500 for each acre shall be paid after the completion of the replanting;
- (d) the fourth instalment of Rs. 250 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than one year after the completion of the replanting;
- (e) the fifth instalment of Rs. 250 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than two years after the completion of the replanting; and
- (f) the sixth instalment of Rs. 250 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than three years after the completion of the replanting.

(2) The amount of the subsidy payable for replanting the whole or any specified part of a rubber estate or rubber small holding shall be Rs. 1,500 in respect of each acre of the area to be replanted, and shall be paid in six instalments as follows:—

- (a) the first instalment of Rs. 200 for each acre shall be paid after the eradication of the existing rubber plants or other vegetation;
- (b) the second instalment of Rs. 400 for each acre shall be paid after soil conservation measures have been adopted;
- (c) the third instalment of Rs. 300 for each acre shall be paid after the completion of the replanting;
- (d) the fourth instalment of Rs. 200 for each acre shall be paid not earlier than one year after the completion of the replanting;
- (e) the fifth instalment of Rs. 200 shall be paid not earlier than two years after the completion of the replanting; and
- (f) the sixth instalment of Rs. 200 shall be paid not earlier than three years after the completion of the replanting."

(3) in regulation 5, by the substitution, for the words " A subsidy for rehabilitation may be paid " of the words " A subsidy for the rehabilitation of the whole or any part of a tea estate or tea small holding may be paid "; and

(4) by the substitution, for regulation 12, of the following regulation:—

" 12. In these regulations—

- (a) " proprietor ", " replanting ", " rubber estate ", " rubber plant ", " rubber small holding ", " rehabilitation ", " tea plant ", " tea estate " and " tea small holding " have the same meanings respectively as in the Tea Subsidy Act, No. 12 of 1958; and
- (b) " Tea Subsidy Fund " means the Tea Subsidy Fund, Established under the Tea Subsidy Act, No. 12 of 1958.
