The Minutes on Pensions dated February 5, 1934, as amended from time to time, are hereby further amended as follows:—

(1) by the substitution, for section 48A, of the following new section:—

"48A. Where any pensionable officer or servant of the Government of Ceylon has relinquished his office or post under the Government with its approval and accepted employment as a full-time member of a statutory body or as an officer or servant of a statutory body or on the staff of a statutory body, he may retain any benefit or qualification that may have accrued to him under these rules, and, accordingly—

(a) in the event of his leaving such employment in any of the following circumstances, that is to say—

(i) retirement on account of age or on the ground of ill-health; or

(ii) abolition of office; or

(iii) removal from office on any ground other than inefficiency or corruption, the following award may be granted to him, namely, such award as might have been granted to him under these rules if he had been retired from the service of the Government of Ceylon on the ground of ill-health on the date on which he took up such employment; or

(b) in the event of his death while in such employment, the following award under these rules may be granted to the person or persons to whom such award is payable under these rules, namely, such award as might have been granted under these rules, if he had died on the date on which he accepted such employment:

In this section—

"abolition of office" in relation to a member of a statutory body shall include vacation of office of the member by effluxion of time, re-appointment not being offered to him;

"statutory body" means a Corporation, Board, University or any other institution established by statute and specified in Schedule H hereto; and

"full-time member" means a member of a statutory body required to engage himself solely in the discharge of duties imposed on him by or under the statute by which such statutory body was established.

The provisions of this section shall be deemed to have come into effect in relation to a full-time member or an officer or servant of a statutory body on the date on which the statute by which such statutory body was established came into operation; and

(2) by the insertion immediately after Schedule G, of the following new Schedule:—
