  (c) The lessee shall, within one year from the commencement of the lease and to the satisfaction of the Government Agent, Vavuniya District, erect on the land such buildings as are necessary to serve as a factory for the manufacture of the articles described in para. I above
  (d) The lessee shall use the land as a site for a factory, and for no other nurpose.
- for no other purpose.
- 3. The lease will be granted unless valid reasons to the contrary are adduced in writing to me within six weeks from the date hereof.
