- (2) In the case of spouses who have not been divorced by the decree of a competent court, or who are not living apart under a duly executed deed of separation, neither spouse shall be deemed to be a middle class Ceylonese for the purposes of this Ordinance if the joint statutory income of both spouses exceeds in the aggregate a sum of twenty-four thousand rupees."
- 4. Applications must be sent under registered cover. The left-hand corner of the envelope should be marked "Application for M. C. C. lands at Galkuliya Forest Reserve". Applications

5. Each selected applicant will be put in possession of 10 acres of land. The applicant is expected to clear, burn and fence the entirety of 10 acres and plant same with coconut or
