NOTIFICATION OF LAND KACHEHERI TO SELECT PERSONS TO RECEIVE LANDS UNDER THE MIDDLE CLASS SCHEME

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent, Puttalam, will hold a Land Kachehri under the Land Development Ordinance at the Puttalam Kachehri to consider applications for lands, particulars of which are given below. The date and time of the Land Kachehri will be notified later to the applicants.

2. Applications will be confined to Middle Class Ceylonese persons resident in the Administrative District of Puttalam or having permanent interests in the above district. A minimum of 10 years' residence is essential.

3. Section 171 of the Land Development Ordinance defines the Middle Class Ceylonese as follows:—

"No person shall for the purpose of this Ordinance be deemed to be a "Middle Class Ceylonese" on a particular date if the statutory income of such person computed under

the provisions of the Income Tax Ordinance, for the year of assessment ending on the thirty-first day of March preceding such date, exceeds a sum of twelve thousand rupees. Provided that—

(1) In the case of spouses, the statutory income of either spouse shall be computed as though separate assessment had been claimed and made in pursuance of notice duly given under the provisions of section 22 of the Income Tax Ordinance;

(2) In the case of spouses who have not been divorced by the decree of a competent court, or who are not living apart under a duly executed deed of separation, neither spouse shall be deemed to be a middle class Ceylonese for the purposes of this Ordinance if the joint statutory income of both spouses exceeds in the aggregate a sum of twenty-four thousand rupees."

4. Applications must be sent under registered cover. The left-hand corner of the envelope should be marked "Application for M. C. O. lands at Galkuliya Forest Reserve". Applications should be in the prescribed form below.

5. Each selected applicant will be put in possession of 10 acres of land. The applicant is expected to clear, burn and fence the entirety of 10 acres and plant same with coconut or

other economic crops within one year of his being put in possession. Thereafter he will be required to maintain the entirety of the plantation in good order.

6. All applications must reach the Government Agent, at the Puttalam Kacheheri on or before December 30, 1958.

7. Every applicant on being informed of the date and time of the Land Kacheheri should attend the Land Kacheheri in person or depute someone to represent him. If neither the applicant nor any person deputed to represent him attends the Land Kacheheri, the Government Agent may presume that the applicant does not wish to pursue his application further.
