Notifications of Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court

COURTS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS it is provided by section 26 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6) that a Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court for the Southern Circuit shall be holden by one of the Judges thereof or by a Commissioner of Assize at Galle and such other places in such circuit as the Chief Justice, after previous consultation with the Judges, shall appoint, such sessions commencing at Galle on April 25 and September 15 in every year,

AND WHEREAS it is further provided that it shall be competent for the Chief Justice, for sufficient reasons to him appearing, to order, after previous consultation with the Judges, other sessions to be holden at the places above mentioned, or at any other place in any of the said circuits either in substitution for or in addition to any of the places above mentioned or to fix any other place for the commencement of any sessions, or to alter the dates above mentioned, and to fix any other date for the commencement of the sessions at any place,

AND WHEREAS an order was made by me in consultation with the Judges that an additional Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court shall be holden at Matara on Monday, 13th October, 1958, which order was published in *Gazette* No. 11,523 of September 12, 1958,

AND WHEREAS it has been decided to postpone the date of commencement of the said additional Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court at Matara to 20th October, 1958.

I, HEMA HENRY BASNAYAKE, Chief Justice, for sufficient reasons to me appearing, do hereby after previous consultation with the Judges, revoke the order published in *Gazette* No. 11,523 of September 12, 1958, and fix Monday, 20th October, 1958, as the date for the commencement of the said additional Criminal Sessions for the Southern Circuit at Matara.
