1. The powers specified in column I of the Schedule hereto are hereby delegated to the officer or officers of the Department of Probation and Child Care Services specified in the corresponding entry in column II of that Schedule, subject to the following conditions:—

Export of Coir Bristle Fibre and Coir Mattress Fibre

THE minimum prices mentioned in the Schedule below will come into force on January 1, 1959. These prices may, however, be reviewed before 15th May, 1959 for the period July 1, to December 31, 1959, should either the shippers or millers so request.

2. The maximum cuts on fibre delivered at shippers' stores which a shipper may make, will continue to be 6 per cent. for mattress fibre and 8 per cent. for bristle fibre.

3. The shippers should insert on the receipts issued by them to the millers, the gross weight of the fibre as well as the net weight of the fibre taken over by them. The millers should send me by the 10th day of each month commencing from February 1959, a statement showing the cuts effected in the preceding month by each shipper together with the receipts issued to them in that month by shippers and one set of copies of such receipts. The original receipts will be returned to millers after examination.

4. No shipper should charge a brokerage or other fee on the prices payable to the millers for the fibre delivered at their stores. The maximum amount that may be charged by a shipper as handling or unloading charges will be 2 cents per cwt.

5. Export licences will be issued only if the exporter satisfies me by documentary evidence that he has paid to the millers from whom purchases are made not less than the prices shown in column II of the schedule below for the lowest grade shown therein.

Estate proprietors who fail to elect and notify me in writing before January 31, 1959, for the year 1959, in terms of the aforementioned section, will be deemed to have elected to pay to the credit of the Food Production Fund for the year 1959, a sum calculated at the rate of ten rupees for each acre of the total cultivated area of the estate, in accordance with the provisions of sections 3 (2) and 6 of the Act.

2. When furnishing the notification required under section 3 (1) of the Act, an estate proprietor who wishes to claim exemption for the year 1959, under section 8 of the Act on account of (1) Animal Husbandry (Milk Production); (2) Animal Husbandry (rearing of pigs, poultry, goats, sheep and castrated bulls); and (3) Cultivation of fruit trees, is requested to specify in the aforesaid notification the particular activity or activities (i.e., one or more of the three activities mentioned above) in respect of which he intends to apply for such exemption for the year 1959.

3. An estate proprietor who owns more than one estate should furnish separate notifications under section 3 of the Act in respect of each such estate owned by him.

4. Estate proprietors are kindly requested to note very carefully that the requirements under sections 3 (2) and 6 of the Act in respect of estate proprietors who fail to elect and notify me before January 31, 1959, as required under section 3 (1) of the Act, will be very strictly enforced during 1959, and that under no circumstances will the application of sections 3 (2) and 6 of the Act be relaxed for the year 1959.

5. Form F. P. 30 which has been introduced to enable estate proprietors to notify me their election in writing, under section 3 (1) of the Act, will be issued to all proprietors of estates now registered with this department. Election under this section should be made in the form *in duplicate* and returned to reach me on or before 31st January, 1959.

6. Any proprietor of an estate who does not receive this Form of election (i.e., Form F. P. 30) before 10th January, 1959, should write to me and obtain one in time to make his election on or before January 31, 1959.

7. In this connection it may be clearly noted that it is not an obligation under the Act on my part to send a Form under section 3 (1) of the Act to proprietors of estates. This is being done purely to facilitate matters for all concerned and I can send Forms only to estates registered with me. Proprietors of estates not so registered should therefore inform me, so that forms could be sent to such proprietors too.

8. If for any reason an estate proprietor does not receive the Form F. P. 30 he should notify his election to me under section 3 (1) of the Act by writing a letter.

9. The Food Production (Estates) Act, No. 40 of 1954, applies to any land or group of lands which forms a separate and distinct property and of which an extent not less than 35 acres is under cultivation for any purpose other than the production of food-stuffs; every such land or group of lands forms an "estate". In this connection it may be noted that the proprietor of an estate or part of an estate cultivated in rubber is, for the present, exempt from the liability to cultivate foodstuffs or pay in lieu thereof in respect only of such estate or part of such estate cultivated in rubber.
