OPPOSITION

NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has grounds of objection to the registration of the following trade marks may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge notice of Opposition on form T. M. No. 7 bearing an uncanceled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration so as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the Notice of Opposition is incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an Opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

"Method of constructing prefabricated reinforced cement concrete houses".

Abstract.—The invention consists of the adoption of precast concrete wall panels, plinth beams and columns in reinforced concrete to form the foundation, pillars and outer walls of a house. In this invention the concrete footings are slotted to receive pre-cast concrete plinth beams. The plinth and the concrete column are in turn slotted to receive pre-cast concrete wall panels. The wall panels themselves are tongued and grooved horizontally to interlock.
