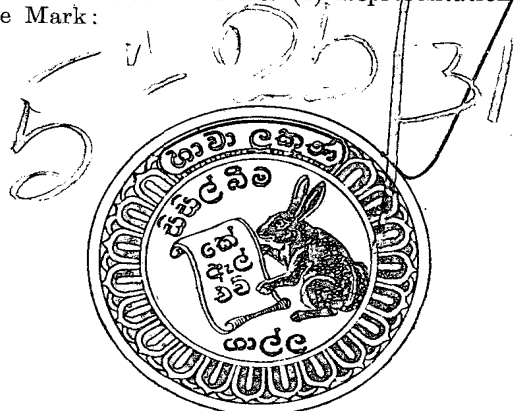

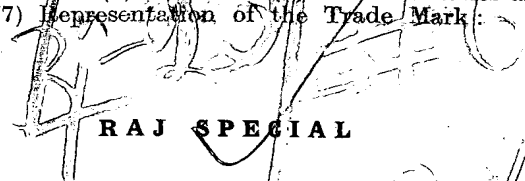

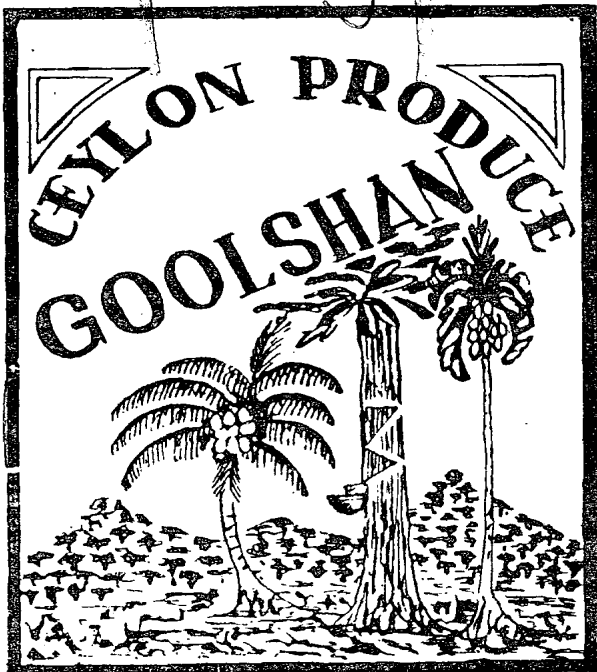

No. 4,515 of December 11, 1957. (*Convention application under section 48, claiming priority date, December 17, 1956*)

SEBASTIAN CASANOVA ESTEVE.

"Improvements in the system for the mechanical manufacture by means of injecting of every type of articles and loose parts using fibro-cement or any other kind of materials susceptible of being shaped into a given form".

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1. Improvements in the manufacture and system for its mechanical production, by means officially stated of injecting, of every description of articles and parts using fibro-cement or any other kind of moulding materials, distinguished because the inner moulding surfaces along which slides and runs the fluid fibro-cemented matter, are kept impregnated with the very same water that gets out of the mixture containing or contained, in the moulding matter, during the sliding of in the injecting operation, for which purpose the inner walls of the mould are covered by a porous round-up covering acting as the water recipient.

THE IMPERIAL TOBACCO COMPANY (OF GREAT BRITAIN AND IRELAND) LTD.

"Improved method and apparatus for treating tobacco".

Abstract.—This invention relates to the treatment of tobacco. It provides a method of treating process tobacco in which fragments of treated material are subjected to the action of high velocity jets of a compressible fluid such as air so as to reduce the said treatment material to powder of the order of 1 to 76 microns, the powder thus obtained being applied to the process tobacco to be treated to which it adheres as a discontinuous coating due to the inherent gumminess and/or other characteristic features of tobacco.

It also provides apparatus for applying powdered treatment material to process tobacco.

“Improvements in or relating to process for recovering vitamin B₁₂

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1. The process for recovering vitamin B₁₂ from a starting material consisting of fermentation broths

obtained by the propagation of a vitamin B₁₂ producing microorganism in a suitable nutrient medium or concentrates thereof, comprising treating the starting material with a substance furnishing cyanide ions, thereby obtaining a reaction mixture containing an increased amount of vitamin B₁₂.

There are 9 claims and 5 examples.
