Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1, 2 and 3 which reads as follows:—

- 1. A method for the preliminary treatment of tea leaf which comprises the step of subjecting a resilient layer of the leaf to a plurality of pressure operations between two substantially non-resilient surfaces.
- 2. A method as claimed in claim 1, which comprises passing the layer of leaf a plurality of times through a pair of substantially non-resilient rollers.
- 3. A method as claimed in claim 1, which comprises passing the layer of leaf through a plurality of pairs of substantially non-resilient rollers.
