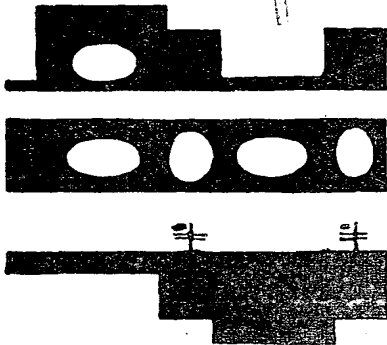

"Improvements in or relating to vacuum flasks"
Abstract.—This invention relates to vacuum flasks and like containers.

The main object of the invention is to provide a construction of pouring lip of the type indicated which has improved sealing contact with the mouth of the flask so that the contents of the flask can be easily poured out without leakage into the space between the flask and its surrounding cannister.

There are 25 claims and 2 sheets of drawings.

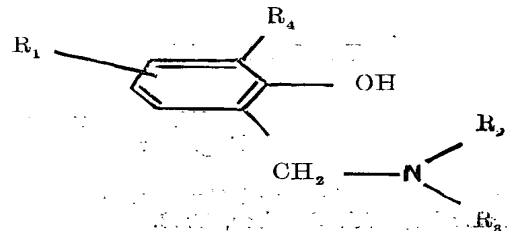

"Method and composition of matter for combating plant diseases."

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1. A method for combating plant fungal diseases which comprises treating the plant, by applying to the surface thereof, with a composition comprising a minor amount of a base represented by the formula



wherein R_1 represents a member of the group consisting of cyclohexyl, phenyl and phenoxy, R_2 represents a member of the group consisting of hydrogen, lower alkyl and 5- to 6-membered saturated heterocyclic ring together with R_3 and the nitrogen atom, R_3 represents a member of the group consisting of lower alkyl and 5- to 6-membered saturated heterocycle together with R_2 and the nitrogen atom, and R_4 represents a member of the group consisting of hydrogen and lower alkyl and acid addition salts of said bases, in an inert medium.

There are seven claims.
