# THE FOOD CONTROL ACT, No. 25 OF 1950 Order No. 103

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (i) of the Food Control Act, No. 25 of 1950, I, Don Philip Rupasinghe Gunawardena, Minister of Agriculture and Food, do by this Order prohibit the transport or removal of any quantity of Paddy from the Jaffna Peninsula, except under the authority of a permit issued by the Deputy Food Controller, Jaffna, or Assistant Food Controller, Jaffna, or otherwise than in accordance with such conditions as may be attached to such permit.

"Jaffna Peninsula" for the purpose of this Order means the Revenue District of Jaffna, exclusive of the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Poonakary-Thunukai, and the Division of Karachchi in the Divisional

Revenue Officer's Division of Pachilapalli-Karachchi.

#### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 4 read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Anton Rothwell McHeyzer, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Trincomalee District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. T/13/58 dated September 17, 1958, published in the Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,529 of September 22, 1958, in so far as it relates to the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price, the retail dealer's maximum retail price and the wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price, mentioned in columns 2, 3 and 4 respectively of the Schedule thereto of Potatoes mentioned in column 1 of that Schedule;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett, a retail dealer's maximum retail price per pound nett to a consumer and a Wholesale Dealer's maximum wholesale price per hundredweight nett respectively above which the article specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the First Schedule shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned at the head of columns 2, 3 and 4;
- (iii) fix with immediate effect the price for the time being fixed by me under column 3 of the First Schedule hereto as the maximum retail price per pound nett within the Trincomalee Urban Council area increased by the amount specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule to be the maximum retail price per pound nett above which the article specified under column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule;

- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule for the purpose of re-sale or any sale of an article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule in a quantity of one hundredweight nett or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of an article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule, less than one hundredweight nett for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule which is adulterated with any other article;
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader, who has any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for such article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule fixed by this Order in that area;

  (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb" shall be deemed to be the standard

- pound avoirdupois weight;
  (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out-
  - (a) the date of the sale;
  - (b) the quantity of such article sold (by weight);

(c) the price paid for the quantity sold;

(d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;

(e) the description of such article;

- (ix) direct that when any article specified in column 1 of the First Schedule is sold, the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article
- (x) direct that in any sale of potatoes in wooden crates imported from Holland the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less tare of ten pounds per crate;
- (xi) direct that in any sale of potatoes in wooden crates imported from China the sale price shall be calculated on gross weight less a tare of thirteen pounds per crate;
- (xii) direct that in any sale of potatoes in wooden crates imported from Japan the sale price shall be
- calculated on gross weight less a tare of twenty-five pounds per crate;
  (xiii) direct that in any sale of any potatoes in any container other than wooden crates, the sale price
- shall be calculated on gross weight less a tare of three pounds per container; (xiv) direct that for the purpose of this Order "nett" shall mean gross weight less tare or naked weight of potatoes.
