THE ESTATE BAZAARS (COMPULSORY ACQUISITION) ACT, No. 19 OF 1958

Decision under Section 3 (1)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Estate Bazaars (Compulsory Acquisition) Act, No. 19 of 1958, I, Charles Percival de Silva, Minister of Lands and Land Development, do hereby decide that the acquisition of the estate bazaar referred to in the undermentioned schedule is required in the public interest.
