MUTTON

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Chelliah Nitkunanathan, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- (i) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices per pound above which mutton of the description and grade specified at the heads of those columns shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule ;
- (ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) “ Mutton ” shall mean the flesh of a sheep or goat, but shall exclude all forms of offal ;
 - (b) when the carcase of a goat or sheep as prepared for sale at the slaughter house (i.e., excluding head, hide, entrails, hooves, all other forms of offal and such parts as are customarily excluded) is sold, the sale shall be deemed to be by “ Dead Weight ”;
 - (c) “ Liver ” shall mean the liver of sheep or goat.
- (iii) direct that when mutton is sold with bones the weight of the bones sold therewith shall not exceed 25 per cent of the total weight sold ;
- (iv) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order every trader, who has any mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule in his possession or under his control at any place or in any vehicle, or any vessel, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place or on that vehicle or that vessel, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices for mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule fixed by this Order in that area ;
- (v) direct that when mutton is sold together with offal in the course of one transaction the mutton shall be weighed and sold separately from the offal ;
- (vi) direct that every trader, when selling mutton or liver, shall so place his weighing scale or scales that the purchaser of the mutton or liver shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the mutton or liver he purchases ;

- (vii) direct that every trader who sells mutton or liver of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the mutton or liver, on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the date of sale;
 - the quantity of mutton or liver sold (by weight);
 - the description of mutton or liver sold; and
 - the price paid for the quantity of mutton or liver sold.
- (viii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell the article specified in the Schedule which is adulterated with any other meat or flesh;
- (ix) direct that when the article specified in the Schedule is sold the maximum prices referred to in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold;
- (x) direct that for the purpose of this Order "pound" or "lb." shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Chelliah Nitkunanathan, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), do by this Order—

- fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum prices per pound above which Country Beef of the description and grade specified at the heads of those columns shall not be sold within the area specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule;
- direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - "Country Beef" shall mean the flesh of domesticated Indian or Sinhala cattle, or buffalo, but shall exclude all forms of offal;
 - when the carcase of any animal as prepared for sale at the slaughter house (i.e., excluding head, hide, entrails, offal, hooves and such parts as are customarily excluded) is sold, the sale shall be deemed to be by "Dead Weight".
- direct that when Country Beef is sold with bones, the weight of the bones sold therewith shall not exceed 25 per cent of the total weight sold;
- direct that every trader who at any premises within the Jaffna District, has in his possession Country Beef of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit conspicuously at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of Country Beef of that description or grade;
- direct that "Country Beef" shall be sold or exposed for sale only in stalls set aside for this purpose and no meat of any other description and grade shall be sold or exposed for sale in those stalls;
- direct that every trader who at any premises within the Jaffna District, has in his possession "Country Beef" of the description and grade specified in that Schedule, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at the stall where such beef is sold a notice to the effect that only Country Beef of that description and grade is sold at the stall;
- direct that when Country Beef is sold together with offal in the course of one transaction, the Country Beef shall be weighed and sold separately from the offal;
- direct that every trader, when selling Country Beef, shall so place his weighing scale or scales that the purchaser of the Country Beef shall be able to ascertain easily the true weight of the Country Beef he purchases;

- (ix) direct that every trader who sells Country Beef of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of the Country Beef, on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
(a) the date of the sale ;
(b) the quantity of Country Beef sold (by weight) ;
(c) the description of Country Beef sold ; and
(d) the price paid for the quantity of Country Beef sold.
- (x) direct that in every area where the maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell the article specified in the Schedule which is adulterated with any other meat or flesh ;
- (xi) direct that when the article specified in the Schedule is sold, the maximum prices referred to in columns 2, 3 and 4 of that Schedule shall include the price of wrapper or container, if any, in which such article is sold ;
- (xii) direct that for the purpose of this Order “ pound ” or “ lb. ” shall be deemed to be the standard pound avoirdupois weight.

SUBSIDIARY FOODSTUFFS

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, read with section 3 (2) of that Act, I, Tuan Isakeen Cassim, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Badulla District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Food Price Order No. BD/41, dated August 22, 1958, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,505 of August 27, 1958, in so far as it relates to the Wholesale Dealer's maximum wholesale price and the retail dealer's maximum retail price mentioned in columns 3 and 4 respectively of the schedule thereto of Dry Chillies mentioned in column 2 of that Schedule ;
- (ii) fix with immediate effect the prices specified in columns 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be a wholesale dealer's maximum wholesale price per cwt. gross to a retail dealer, a retail dealer's maximum retail price per lb. nett to a consumer, respectively, above which the article specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of that Schedule shall not be sold within the limits mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule thereto ;
- (iii) direct that paragraphs (iii) to (viii) of Food Price Order No. BD/41 of August 22, 1958, relating to Subsidiary Foodstuffs published in *Ceylon Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 11,505 of August 27, 1958, shall apply in the case of Dry Chillies mentioned in column 2 of the Schedule hereto as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.
