THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE

REGULATION made by the Minister of Education and approved by the Senate and the House of Representatives under Section 32 of the Education Ordinance, No. 31 of 1939, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947.

Regulation

The Code of Regulations for Assisted Vernacular and Bilingual Schools published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,722 of July 12, 1929, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended in regulation 59A (inserted by regulation published in *Gazette* No. 9,679 of March 14, 1947) in paragraph (2) thereof, by the substitution for sub-paragraph (c), of the following new sub-paragraph :—

“(c) Every member of the teaching staff shall be a Graduate, or a trained teacher, who has passed the Government Senior School Certificate or the London Matriculation Examination or any higher examination of any University recognised by the Director with Sinhalese or Tamil as one of the subjects in such examination.”
