The Award

This is an award under section 17 of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments, Ceylon (Revised Edition), as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts Nos. 14 and 62 of 1957. It relates to an industrial dispute between the Ceylon Workers' Congress, 84/4, Luaries Road, Colombo 4, (hereinafter referred to as the "Congress") and the Superintendent of Norwood Estate, Norwood, (hereinafter referred to as the "Superintendent").

- 2. The Deputy Commissioner of Labour has by his order dated 18th April, 1959, made under section 3 (1) (d) of the aforesaid Act, referred to me for settlement by arbitration the above dispute, more specifically set out in his statement of 18th August, 1959, as follows:—
 - "The matter in dispute between the Ceylon Workers' Congress and The Superintendent of Norwood Estate, Norwood, is whether the non-employment of the following workers by The Superintendent of the Estate, Norwood, is just they are entitled:—
 - (1) Katurasa.
 - (2) Thangavelu.
 - (3) Caruppiah.
 - (4) Saverimuthu.
 - (5) S. Pootchy.
 - (6) Subramaniam."
- 3. The inquiry commenced only on 12th June, 1961, after the usual exchange of statements by the parties to the dispute, as required by the Industrial Disputes Regulations. Mr. Advocate T. W. Rajaratnam instructed by Mr. M. P. Sunderam appeared for the Ceylon Workers' Congress and Mr. Advocate R. A. Kannangara instructed by Mr. P. N. Bartholomeusz appeared for the Superintendent of Norwood Estate. It would appear that there was a case filed in the Magistrate's Court of Hatton connected with the matter referred to this court for settlement and both parties awaited a decision of the relevant Magistrate in that case before' they exchanged statements as required by the Regulations. The hearing was further delayed owing to the absence of the Superintendent of Norwood Estate from the Island for a short holiday during the proceedings. However; the proceedings concluded on 10th February, 1962, and all connected papers were in my hands in the first week of March, 1962.

 4. The Ceylon Workers' Congress formed a Union in the lower division of Norwood Estate somewhere in February 1959 and it was claimed that approximately 400 out of 450 labourers joined this union. The first committee meeting of the newlyformed union was held on the 18th February, 1959. There was friction between Palanisamy, K. P. and the union from the every start. The version of the management is that since the formation of the union there was regular interference by the union with Palanisamy, K. P. and other supervisory staff which disturbed the smooth working of the Estate. Two cifice bearers of the union, in particular Katurasa, the President, and Saverimuthu, Vice-Captain of the Thondars, were said to have been unscrupulous antagonists of Palanisamy K. P. On the 17th March there was a sudden stoppage of work by the labourers of the lower division for a whole day to attend a funeral when the normal practice was to stop work at 2 p.m. on the day of the funeral. On the 20th March, 1959, there was a minor incident between a labourer called Rasu and a watcher called Doraisamy. The union took the side of Rasu, and Katurasa, the President, insisted on holding an inquiry into the incident at the evening muster on the same day. Words were exchanged between union leaders on the one hand, and the K. P. and the watcher, Doraisamy, on the other. There was a disturbance at the muster as a resuit of which stones were pelted at Palanisamy K. P., Doraisamy and Veeraputran, a plucking K. P. Doraisamy and others received injuries which were treated at the hospital. A case was filed on this incident in the Magistrate's Court, Hatton, and later compounded before the Magistrate.
- 5. In the morning of the 21st March, Mr. H. F. Ratwatte, Assistant Superintendent, who was acting for Mr. Hazell, the Superintendent of the Estate, who had gone away on short leave, attended the muster in the lower division and informed personally those concerned to attend an inquiry in his office that morning. He asked, among others, the six union leaders to attend his office in the morning on the same day. The union leaders, however, did not attend the inquiry because according to them they could not do so as they were detained by the police that morning and only released from the remand jail on the 23rd March. The management was of the opinion that the labourers could have attended the inquiry in the Estate before they went to the police. There is evidence to show that the labourers were at the police station shortly after 9.30 a.m. on the same day, and I am unable to accept that their action in not obeying the orders of Mr. Ratwatte amounted to insubordination. They might have gone to his office after attending the police inquiry that the case through resident of the 20th March.
- 6. Regarding the stone-throwing incident of the 20th March, even if it was established that every one of these six labourers threw stones at Doraisamy and the supervisory staff, one cannot resist entertaining a doubt whether this was not an incident that arose in the heat of the moment between the two parties and had nothing to do with the management. However, it must be admitted that such high-handed action, misconduct and hooliganism on the part of labourers cannot but undermine discipline in an estate.
- 7. The other instance of alleged insubordination and indiscipline according to the management took place on the 24th March where the six labourers refused to attend office for an inquiry by the Acting Superintendent after their return from the remand jail. This to my mind is a serious disobedience to

orders. The labourers did not even this time give the management orders. The labourers did not even this time give the management an opportunity to inquire into the incidents and their grievances and take suitable action to prevent incidents of this nature and restore better relations between all parties. The submission that the union leaders had no confidence in Mr. Ratwatte holding an inquiry is not a valid reason for disobeying his orders. It might be mentioned here that for no reason there was a stoppage of work in the lower division on the 24th and 25th March. This must have caused financial loss to both parties.

- 8. Mr. Hazell, the permanent Superintendent, resurned to the Estate on the 25th March after 8 p.m. The six labourers were issued notices of dismissal at about 3 p.m. on 27th March. The reasons for dismissal, as set out in the notice, are as
- " (a) For being involved in a disturbance at the time of marking names in the evening on Friday, 20th March, 1959.
- (b) For your failure to carry out the lawful orders of Mr. Hector Felix Ratwatte, Acting Superintendent, on Saturday, 21st March, 1959, and Tuesday, 24th March, without just cause."

I have discussed all three incidents of the 20th, 21st and 24th

- 9. Although to my mind the incidents referred to do not by themselves constitute grave offences which merit the dismissal of these workers, except the incident of the 24th March where the workers refused to carry out the orders of the Acting Superintendent, yet the cumulative effect of such actions would tend to undermine discipline and destroy the good employer-employee relations which are necessary for the smooth working of an estate which employs a large number of persons.
- 10. In the circumstances I hold that the non-employment of the six labourers by the Superintendent is justified. However, taking into consideration their length of service and past records I order that an ex-gratia payment be made to them as follows:—

CONTROL OF YEHICULAR TRAFFIC AT THE RAILWAY LEVEL CROSSING AT STATION ROAD, KELANIYA

WITH effect from 25th March, 1962, the existing wooden gates at the above level crossing will be removed and MOTOR WORKED BARRIERS (of the Toll-Bar Type) will be installed. The road way over the level crossing would be divided into a dual carriage way with Colour Light road signals for the control of vehicular traffic. Drivers of all vehicles shall obey the light signals which will operate in accordance with the following system:—

- 1. At a distance of 27 feet ahead of each barrier, a white line hereinafter called the STOP LINE drawn across the highway is provided in conjunction with each road light signal.
- 2. At a distance of 20 feet to the rear of the stop line, a Colour Light signal consisting of three lamps, one Red; one Amber and one Green, Facing the stream of traffic which the signal is intended to control is errected.

- 3. The lamps are arranged vertically, with the lamp showing the red light being the uppermost and that showing the green light the lowermost.
- 4. The sequence of the signal lights for the purpose of controlling vehicular traffic will be as follows:—
 - (i) Red with the word "STOP" on the lense of the lamp.
- (ii) Amber and Red together.
- (iii) Green with the word "GO" on the lense of the lamp.
- (iv) Amber.
- 5. The significance of the light signals aforesaid is as follows:—
 - (i) The Red signal indicates that no vehicular traffic is to proceed beyond the stop line until the Green signal is shown.
- (ii) The Amber with Red signal indicates an impending change in the signal from Red to Green; but does not alter the prohibitory significance of the red signal.
- (iii) The Green signal indicates that traffic may pass the signal and proceed straight on with due regard to the safety of other users of the highway and subject to any directions which may be given by a Police Officer or other duely authorised person engaged in the regulation of traffic.

- (iv) The Amber signal shown alone indicates an impending change in the signal to Red and shall be taken as prohibiting all traffic from the proceeding beyond the STOP LINE.
- 6. If and when these light signals be defective, drivers of all vehicles shall obey hand signals exhibited at the level crossing gate.
