“48H (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these Minutes, a medical officer in the Department of Health Services, who had opted to function as a part-time officer in that Department in the capacity of a specialist but who had thereafter declined to opt for full-time service in that Department with effect from January 1, 1962, may, if he, by written notice given to the Director of Health Services on a date not later than December 31, 1961, has elected to retire from service and if three months' notice of such retirement has been given by him on date not later than April 1, 1962, be granted upon his retirement a pension or gratuity of such amount as would have been awarded to him under these minutes if he had retired from service on the ground of ill-health.

The Award

This is an award under section 17 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments, Ceylon (Revised Edition), as amended by the Industrial Disputes

(Amendment) Acts, Nos. 14 and 62 of 1957. It relates to a dispute between the Lanka Estate Workers' Union, 47, Driberg's Avenue, Colombo 10 (hereinafter referred to as the "Union") and the Management of Deldeniya Estate, Kegalla (hereinafter referred to as the "Management").

2. The Hon'ble the Minister of Labour and Nationalised Services, by his Order dated 26th October, 1961, made under section 4 (1) of the aforesaid Act, referred this matter to me for settlement by arbitration. The Acting Commissioner of Labour has by his statement dated 17th October, 1961, stated that the matter in dispute is whether the non-employment of the following workers is justified, and to what relief they are entitled:

- (1) A. Simon,
- (2) Nandawathie,
- (3) P. A. Jeewathahamy,
- (4) A. P. Luciya.

3. The matter came up for inquiry on 11th December, 1961, but the Management was not represented on that date and the court proceeded to inquiry under Regulation 28 framed under the aforesaid Act. The counsel representing the Union moved for a postponement to produce the notes of the conference held at the Labour Office, Kegalla, on 25th November, 1960, and a copy of the letter from the Union to the Management, dated 16th February, 1961.

4. The inquiry was thereupon postponed for the following day for the production of these documents. On that date the Counsel for the Union produced the two documents and the court put off the award for 20th December, 1961. On 20th December, 1961, Mr. A. M. Markar, Proctor, appeared for the Superintendent, and moved that he be allowed an opportunity to state his case, on the ground that his client was prevented from appearing in this case, owing to the bus strike. His application was allowed on condition that the Superintendent paid the sum of Rs. 105 as costs of the Union before the next date of inquiry.

5. On the next date the matter was inquired into, and in the course of the inquiry the matter was settled by the Management undertaking to give sillara work to the four workers, A. Simon, his wife Nandawathie, P. A. Jeewathahamy and A. P. Luciya from 1st February, 1962. The Labour Officer, Kegalla, was to see that these four workers presented themselves for work on that day.

6. I hold that the terms of settlement are just and equitable and make award accordingly.
