Regulations

REGISTRATION OF PROFESSIONS AND BUSINESSES

1. (1) Every application for registration, or for the renewal of registration, for the purposes of Part VII of the Act by any person practising any profession shall be substantially in

Form RPB 1 set out in the Schedule hereto. The applicant shall set out in the Form all such particulars as are required to be set out therein. The Form, when it is duly completed, shall be sent by the applicant—

(a) if he is resident within the Administrative District of Colombo, to the principal office of the Commissioner or to such other office as the Commissioner may direct, and

(b) if he is resident outside the Administrative District of Colombo, to the Government Agent of the Administrative District in which the applicant resides or, where he is so directed by the Commissioner, to the principal office of the Commissioner.

(2) Upon receipt of an application made under paragraph (1), the officer in charge of the office to which it was sent—

(a) shall cause the application to be numbered and cause the number assigned to the application together with the name and address of, and the profession practised by, the applicant to be entered in a register (hereinafter referred to as the "Primary Register of Professions and Businesses");

(b) shall, if the applicant is liable to pay a fee for registration, cause to be sent to him a paying-in-slip in which the amount of such fee and the office at which such fee is to be paid shall be specified; and

(c) shall, if the applicant is liable to pay the National Development Tax and has opted to pay such tax in instalments, determine the number of such instalments (not exceeding four in number) and the date on or before which each instalment shall be paid and provide him with Form RPB 2 set out in the Schedule hereto to enable him to furnish an undertaking to pay such tax in instalments.

(3) An applicant shall, upon receipt of the paying-in-slip pay the registration fee at the office specified in such paying-in-slip, and shall send the receipt issued to him by such office in acknowledgment of the payment of such fee together with the Form RPB 2, if any, duly completed and signed to the office to which he sent his application for registration. Thereupon the officer in charge of the last-mentioned office shall cause such applicant to be registered and shall issue or cause to be issued to such applicant a certificate of registration in Form RPB 3A set out in the Schedule hereto. Where an application for registration is made by a person who is not liable to pay a fee for such registration, the officer in charge of the office to which such application is sent shall cause such applicant to be registered and shall issue or cause to be issued to such applicant a certificate of registration in Form RPB 3AA set out in the Schedule hereto. A certificate of registration shall not be issued under this paragraph to a person who is liable to pay National Development Tax unless such person has paid such tax or has undertaken to pay such tax in instalments.

(4) Where a certificate of registration is issued to any person under paragraph (3) the officer by whom such certificate was issued shall enter or cause to be entered in the appropriate place in the Primary Register of Professions and Businesses the amount of the registration fee, if any, paid by such person, the number of the certificate of registration issued to him and the amount of the National Development Tax, if any, due from him.

(5) Every application for the renewal of a certificate of registration issued under paragraph (3) shall be made at least thirty days before the date on which such certificate is due to expire.

2. (1) Every application for registration, or for the renewal of registration, for the purposes of Part VII of the Act by any person carrying on any business shall be in Form RPB 1 set out in the Schedule hereto. The applicant shall set out in the Form all such particulars as are required to be stated therein. The Form, when it is duly completed, shall be sent by the applicant—

(a) if he carries on such business within the Administrative District of Colombo, to the principal office of the Commissioner or to such other office as the Commissioner may direct, and

(b) if he carries on such business outside the Administrative District of Colombo, to the Government Agent of the Administrative District in which the applicant carries on his business or, where he is so directed by the Commissioner, to the principal office of the Commissioner.

(2) Upon receipt of an application made under paragraph (1), the officer in charge of the office to which it was sent—

(a) shall cause the application to be numbered and cause the number assigned to the application together with the name and address of the applicant, and the nature of the business carried on by the applicant, and the place where such business is carried on, to be entered in the Primary Register of Professions and Businesses;

(b) shall, if the applicant is liable to pay a fee for registration, cause to be sent to him a paying-in-slip in which the amount of such fee and the office at which such fee is to be paid shall be specified; and

(c) shall, if the applicant is liable to pay the National Development Tax and has opted to pay such tax in instalments, determine the number of such instalments (not exceeding four in number) and the date on or before which each instalment shall be paid and provide him with Form RPB 2 set out in the Schedule hereto to enable him to furnish an undertaking to pay such tax in instalments.

(3) An applicant shall, upon receipt of the paying-in-slip, pay the registration fee at the office specified in such paying-in-slip and shall send the receipt issued to him by such office in acknowledgment of the payment of the fee together with the Form RPB 2, if any, duly completed and signed to the office to which he sent his application for registration. Thereupon the officer in charge of the last-mentioned office shall cause such applicant to be registered and shall issue or cause to be issued to such applicant a certificate of registration in Form RPB 3B set out in the Schedule hereto. Where an application is made by a person who is not liable to pay a fee for such registration, the officer in charge of the office to which such application is sent shall cause such applicant to be registered and shall issue or cause to be issued to such applicant a certificate of registration in Form RPB 3BB set out in the Schedule hereto. A certificate of registration shall not be issued to a person who is liable to pay National Development Tax unless such person has paid such tax or has undertaken to pay such tax in instalments.

(4) Where a certificate of registration is issued to any person under paragraph (3), the officer by whom such certificate was issued shall enter or cause to be entered in the appropriate place in the Primary Register of Professions and Businesses the amount of the registration fee, if any, paid by such person, the number of the certificate of registration issued to him and the amount of the National Development Tax, if any, due from him.

(5) Every application for the renewal of a certificate of registration issued under paragraph (3) shall be made at least thirty days before the date on which such certificate is due to expire.

3. A certificate of registration issued under these regulations to a Ceylonese shall be—

- (a) yellow in colour, if no fee is paid by him for the purposes of registration,
- (b) blue in colour, if the fee paid by him is two hundred rupees,
- (c) dark red in colour, if the fee paid by him is two hundred and fifty rupees;
- (d) pink in colour, if the fee paid by him is three hundred rupees, and
- (e) green in colour, if the fee paid by him is three hundred and fifty rupees.

A certificate of registration issued under these regulations to a non-Ceylonese shall be white in colour.

4. (1) The Commissioner shall cause to be kept and maintained in respect of each Administrative District—

- (a) a register to be known as the Secondary Register of Professions; and
- (b) a register to be known as the Secondary Register of Businesses.

(2) The Secondary Register of Professions shall contain the name of every person practising a profession who is for the time being registered for the purposes of Part VII of the Act and who is liable to pay the National Development Tax and such other particulars relating to him as are entered in the Primary Register of Professions and Businesses. The names of such persons shall be arranged in alphabetical order according to the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division, the ward of the local authority and the village headman's division in which they are resident.

(3) The Secondary Register of Businesses shall contain the name of any person carrying on a business who is for the time being registered for the purposes of Part VII of the Act and who is liable to pay the National Development Tax and such other particulars relating to him as are entered in the Primary Register of Professions and Businesses. The names of such persons shall be arranged in alphabetical order according to the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division, the ward of the local authority and the village headman's division in which they are resident.

5. (1) Where any National Development Tax is in default, the Commissioner may issue a certificate to the Fiscal specifying the amount of such tax and the name and last known place of residence of the defaulter and the Fiscal shall thereupon seize and sell all or any of the movable property of the defaulter or such part thereof as he may deem necessary for recovery of the tax.

(2) Where any National Development Tax is in default and the Commissioner is of opinion that recovery under paragraph (1) is impracticable or inexpedient, he may issue a certificate to the District Court having jurisdiction in any district where the defaulter resides or in which any property movable or immovable owned by the defaulter is situate, specifying the amount of such tax and the name and address of the defaulter, and the Court shall thereupon direct a writ of execution to issue to the Fiscal authorising and requiring him to seize and sell all or any of the property movable or immovable of the defaulter, or such part

thereof as he may deem necessary for recovery of the tax, and the provisions of sections 226 to 297 of the Civil Procedure Code shall, *mutatis mutandis*, apply to such seizure and sale.

(3) For the purposes of this regulation, National Development Tax shall be deemed to be in default if such tax or any instalment of such tax is not paid on the date on which the payment should have been made and the person who failed to pay such tax or any instalment thereof on that date shall be deemed to be a defaulter in respect of such tax or instalment.

6. The Commissioner shall refund any sum paid by a person in excess of the amount of the National Development Tax due from him if such person makes an application in that behalf to the Commissioner within twenty-four months after the date on which such sum was paid.

7. For the purposes of this Part—

- “ Act ” means The Finance Act, No. 65 of 1961;
- “ businesses ” and “ Commissioner ” shall have the same meaning as in the Act;
- “ Ceylonese ” and “ non-Ceylonese ” shall have the same meaning as in the Third Schedule to the Act.

Regulations

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rice Subsidy Tax Regulations, 1962.

2. (1) The amount payable by an individual under section 30 of the Act shall be paid on or before the date specified in that behalf in any notice of assessment or additional assessment issued to him under the Income Tax Ordinance (Chapter 242).

(2) Where the amount is not paid on or before such date, such amount shall be deemed to be in default, and may be recovered in like manner as income tax is recoverable under the Income Tax Ordinance (Chapter 242).

(3) The provisions of sections 84 to 88 of the Income Tax Ordinance (Chapter 242) shall, *mutatis mutandis*, apply to the recovery of the amount in default.

3. Where the Food Controller or any officer authorised in that behalf issues to an individual a certificate to the effect that the ration book to which such individual is entitled was not issued to that individual, then—

(a) if such certificate relates to a whole year of assessment, such individual shall not be liable to make any payment under section 30 of the Act in respect of that ration book for that year of assessment; and

(b) if such certificate relates only to a part of a year of assessment, the amount payable under section 30 of the Act by such individual in respect of that ration book shall be an amount which bears to the amount payable under section 30 of the Act in respect of a ration book for a year of assessment the same proportion as the number of complete weeks in the remaining part of that year of assessment bears to the number 52.

4. If any individual surrenders his ration book to the Food Controller or any officer authorised in that behalf on any date prior to the date on which any year of assessment commences, and if he is issued by the Food Controller or any officer authorised in that behalf a certificate to the effect that such individual has surrendered his ration book and that no ration book will be re-issued to him in that year of assessment, such

individual shall not be liable to make any payment under section 30 of the Act in respect of that ration book for that year of assessment.

5. If any individual surrenders his ration book to the Food Controller or any other officer authorised in that behalf on any date subsequent to the date on which any year of assessment commences, and if he is issued by the Food Controller or any officer authorised in that behalf a certificate to the effect that such individual has surrendered his ration book and that no ration book will be re-issued to him till the end of that year of assessment, the amount payable under section 30 of the Act by such individual in respect of that ration book shall be an amount which bears to the amount payable under section 30 of the Act in respect of a ration book for a year of assessment the same proportion as the number of complete weeks in the portion of the year of assessment ending on the date of surrender of the ration book bears to the number 52:

Provided that where the Food Controller or any officer authorised on that behalf, states in the certificate issued to such individual that, prior to the date of surrender of the ration book, such individual has not drawn rice rations in respect of that ration book for such number of complete weeks in that year of assessment as is specified in such certificate, the amount payable by such individual under the preceding provisions of this regulation shall be reduced by an amount which bears to the amount payable under section 30 of the Act in respect of a ration book for a year of assessment the same proportion as the number of complete weeks specified in such certificate bears to the number 52.

6. No claim for relief by any individual under these regulations shall be allowed unless such individual adduces proof in support thereof, to the satisfaction of the Commissioner.

7. In these regulations—

"Act" means the Finance Act, No. 65 of 1961; and

"Commissioner" shall have the same meaning as in the Act.
